Rachel Michelle Stabler, who was born in America's landlocked heartland but came to cherish the saltwater paradise of her adopted home in the Florida Keys, died at her residence in Key Largo after a short illness. She was forty-six years old.

For decades, Rusty explored the waters of the Florida Bay, the Everglades, and the Gulf of Mexico, first as a youngster in her own skill, and later as a charter fishing guide, taking anglers onto the saltwater flats or into secluded mangrove swamps in search of tarpon, bonefish and other elusive prey.

Born in Starkville, Okla., Rusty arrived in the Keys at the age of six with her mother, Ellen Stabler, who had come to those remote islands seeking a fresh start. Rusty completed high school at Coral Gables Senior High in Tavernier where she graduated with her studies. "As a child, she fell in with a tough
