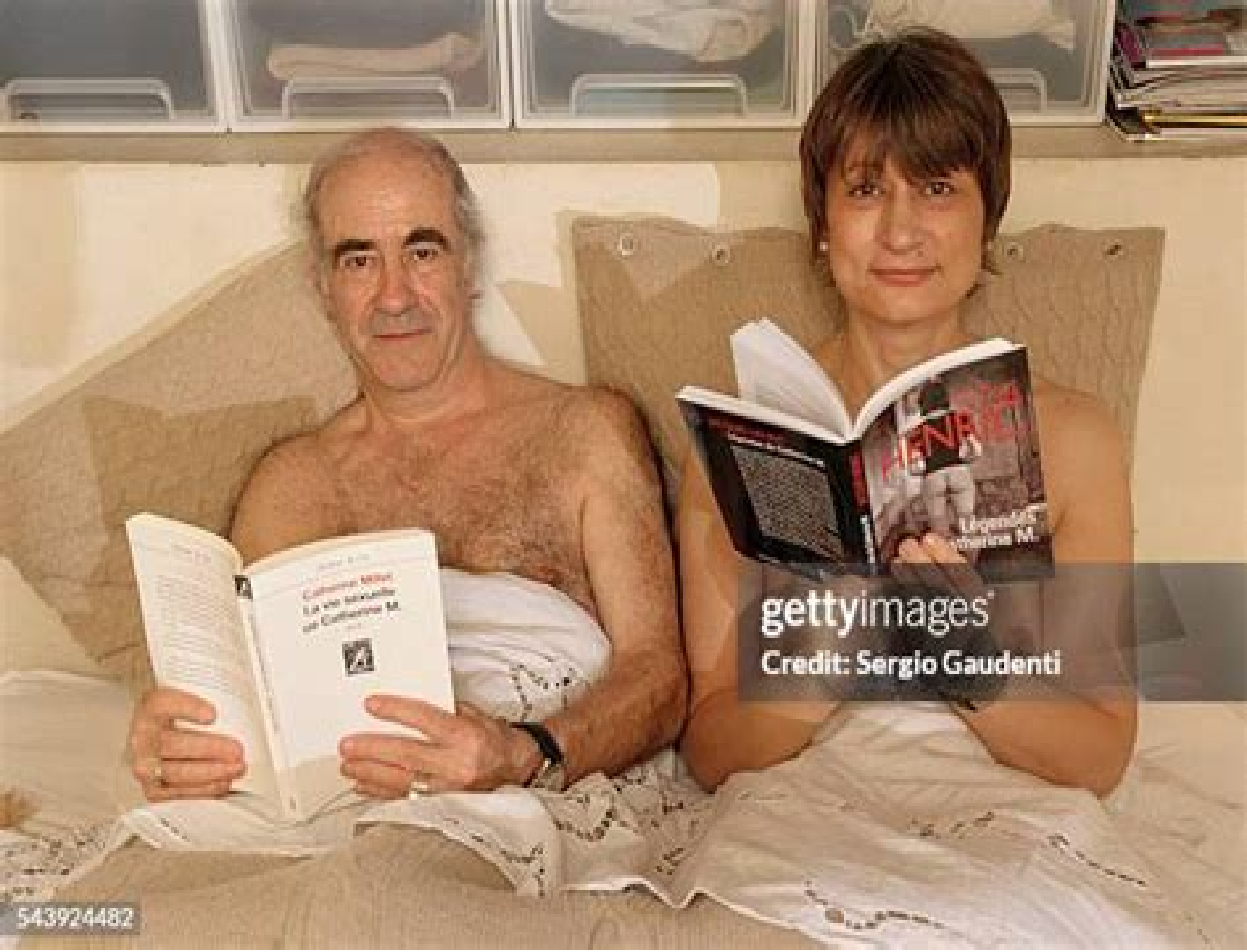

Not My Mother's Sister Astrid Henry, 2004-09-07 No matter how wise a mother's advice is we listen to our peers At least that's writer Naomi Wolf's take on the differences between her generation of feminists the third wave and the feminists who came before her and developed in the late 60s and 70s the second wave In *Not My Mother's Sister* Astrid Henry agrees with Wolf that this has been the case with American feminism but says there are problems inherent in drawing generational lines Henry begins by examining texts written by women in the second wave and illustrates how that generation identified with yet also disassociated itself from its feminist foremothers Younger feminists now claim the movement as their own by distancing themselves from the past By focusing on feminism's debates about sexuality they are able to reject the so called victim feminism of Catherine MacKinnon and Andrea Dworkin Rejecting the orthodoxies of the second wave younger feminists celebrate a woman's right to pleasure Henry asserts however that by ignoring diverse older voices the new generation has oversimplified generational conflict and has underestimated the

contributions of earlier feminists to women's rights. They have focused on issues relating to personal identity at the expense of collective political action. Just as writers like Wolf Kittling and Rene Denfeld celebrate a new feminist heterosexuality posited in generational terms, queer and lesbian feminists of the third wave similarly distance themselves from those who came before. Henry shows how 1970s lesbian feminism is represented in ways that are remarkably similar to the puritanical portrait of feminism offered by straight third wavers. She concludes by examining the central role played by feminists of color in the development of third wave feminism. Indeed, the term third wave itself was coined by Rebecca Walker, daughter of Alice Walker. *Not My Mother's Sister* is an important contribution to the exchange of ideas among feminists of all ages and persuasions.

Telemorphosis Jean Baudrillard, 2015-07-31 The art of living today has shifted to a continuous state of the experimental. Leo Bersani, 2009-12-15 Over the course of a distinguished career, critic Leo Bersani has tackled a range of issues in his writing, and this collection gathers together some of his finest work. Beginning with one of the foundations of queer theory, his famous meditation on how sex leads to a shattering of the self, *Is the Rectum a Grave?* this volume charts the inspired connections Bersani has made between sexuality, psychoanalysis, and aesthetics. For Bersani, art represents a crucial guide for conceiving new ways of connecting to the world, and so in many of these essays, he stresses the importance of aesthetics, analyzing works by Genet, Caravaggio, Proust, Almodóvar, and Godard. reflection the volume presents careful conceptual analyses of terrorism while demonstrating that the relation between reason and terrorism is deeply rooted in the history of philosophy In a series of historical essays that begins with Lucretius reflections on terror includes Machiavelli and Hegel s political analyses and continues through Arendt s investigation of terror and ideology the authors counter a prevalent tendency to think that terrorism is irrational and hence beyond the pale of philosophical reflection The collection continues by investigating contemporary terrorism s impact upon subjectivity communication and rhetoric and the practice of philosophy Taken as a whole the essays demonstrate not only philosophy s ability to think terrorism but also terrorism s impact on philosophy

Repair the World Alexandre Gefen, 2024-08-19 Talk of repair has become ubiquitous in recent years In the age of trauma culture art and literature have a new purpose to do justice to console comfort and heal Drawing on works of twenty first century French language literature this monograph shows how literature can not only serve as a means of personal development but expand our capacity for empathy help repair the brokenness implied in victimhood and redress individual and collective traumas Centered on a critical reflection on discourses of repair and reparations it questions the canonical theories on the functions of literature and proposes a new way of writing and reading literary history Praise *Repair the World* is an invigorating and essential call to arms The modern category of the literary it declares is being outpaced by the contemporary uses of literature as a medium of exorcism empathy reparation testimony commemoration existential renewal and ethical or political connectivity Neither celebrating nor condemning such uses Gefen models a much needed style of criticism interdisciplinary pragmatic relational that comes to grips with their importance Rita Felski the John Stewart Bryan Professor and Professor of English at the University of Virginia USA In an era where self help memoir and autobiography command more than their fair share of publisher s lists in France it s tempting some fifty years after post structuralism s heyday to ascribe an impending death of literature to a taste for narcissistic exhibitionism in French literary culture But why bemoan the waning relevance of the question what is literature asks Alexandre Gefen when evidence abounds in the new century that literary writing increasingly posits itself as a restorative reparative act In the best instances authors who give form to embodied experience imaginatively forge with their readers empathetic bonds of the sort that secular and religious institutions long sustained *Repair the World* is not only a capacious study of writers who hail from surprisingly broad sectors of French society from health and social workers to skilled laborers journalists and educators it s a situated call for a pragmatics of reading that makes of each book an intervention into the fabric of the real Harnessing sources in affect theory trauma studies ethics and cognitive science Alexandre Gefen performs a critically reparative act all his own reminding us that the notion of literature as autonomous object was itself a historical construct in short an ideology Reading and writing have always conjoined care for the self and care for others and it s upon that reciprocity that the communities of sense of tomorrow can flourish in a spirit of reparative humanism Derek Schilling Professor of French Director of the Centre Louis Marin Department of Modern Languages and
