Women and Portraits in Early Modern Europe Andrea Pearson, 2016-12-05 As one of the first books to treat portraits of early modern women as a discrete subject this volume considers the possibilities and limits of agency and identity for women in history and with particular attention to gender as categories of analysis for women's images Its nine original essays on Italy the Low Countries Germany France and England deepen the usefulness of these analytical tools for portraiture Among the book's broad contributions it dispels false assumptions about agency's possibilities and limits showing how agency can be located outside of conventional understanding and conversely how it can be stretched too far It demonstrates that agency is compatible with relational gender analysis especially when alternative agencies such as spectatorship are taken into account It also makes evident the importance of aesthetics for the study of identity and agency The individual essays reveal among other things how portraits broadened the traditional parameters of portraiture explored transvestism and same sex eroticism appropriated aspects of male portraiture to claim those values for their sitters and as sites for gender negotiation resistance and debate invoked considerable relational anxiety Richly layered in method the book offers an array of provocative insights into its subject

The Politics of Female Households is the first collection that seeks to integrate ladies in waiting into the master narrative of early modern court studies. Presenting evidence and analysis of the multifarious ways in which women above stairs shaped the European courts of the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries, it argues for a re-assessment of their political influence. The cultural agency of ladies in waiting is viewed in the reflection of portraiture pamphlets and masques; their political dealings and patronage are revealed through analysis of letters, family networks, career patterns, gift exchange and household structures as well as their activities in the fields of intelligence gathering and espionage. By concentrating on a previously neglected area of female agency, this collection demonstrates clearly that the political climate of Europe was often shaped outside the male dominated institutions of government and administration. An important contribution to growing scholarship on women's participation in literary cultures, this essay collection concentrates on cross-national communities of letters to offer a comparative and international approach to early modern women's writing. The essays gathered here focus on multiple literatures from several countries ranging from Italy and France to the Low Countries and England. Individual essays investigate women in diverse social classes and life stages ranging from siblings and mothers to nuns to celebrated writers; the collection overall is invested in crossing geographic, linguistic, political and religious borders and exploring familial, political and religious communities. Taken together, these essays offer fresh ways of reading early modern women's writing that consider such issues as the changing cultural geographies of the early modern world, women's bilingualism and multilingualism and women's sense of identity mediated by local, regional, national and transnational affiliations and conflicts.

Women in the Great European Revolutions Bailey Stone, 2025-10-30. This book explores and compares the roles, mentalities and destinies of elitist and working-class women in Europe's most dramatic revolutions: England's Puritan Revolution of 1640-1660, France's 1789 Revolution and Russia's 1917 Revolution. By providing one of the most detailed analyses to date of how feminist historians, sociologists and specialists theorize gender, sexuality and patriarchy, the author draws connections to current debate over the causation of sociopolitical revolutions and how such scholars speculate about the long-term implications of such revolutions for women in the USA and in other countries. This book briefly outlines the stage-by-stage progression of events in the English, French and Russian Revolutions, thus enabling the general reader to contextualize more easily its discussion of women's revolutionary experiences in those countries. This book reappraises the relative importance ascribable to gendered cultural and to statist geopolitical factors through the disastrous revolutionary careers of three consort queens: i.e. Henrietta Maria of England, Marie Antoinette of France and Alexandra Feodorovna of Russia, by contrasting their political failings with the political acumen of three earlier regnant

queens in these three countries i e Elizabeth I Cath rine de M dicis and Catherine II the Great Finally this book demonstrates how women of humble social station used these unheard of revolutionary situations either to express their grievances and voice their social aspirations or on the other hand to reaffirm their long held allegiance to traditional principles customs and religion It concludes by discussing race ethnicity and statism as challenging issues that need to be confronted in any current discussion of women s revolutionary experiences

Women's Agency in Early Modern Britain and the American Colonies Rosemary O'Day,2014-06-11 Women in early modern Britain and colonial America were not the weak husband and father dominated characters of popular myth Quite the reverse strong women were the norm They exercised considerable influence as important agents in the social economic religious and cultural life of their societies This book shows how women on both sides of the Atlantic while accepting a patriarchal system with all its advantages and disadvantages contrived to carve out for themselves meaningful lives Unusually it concentrates not only on the making and meaning of marriage but also upon the partnership between men and women It also looks at the varied roles cultural religious and educational that women played both inside and outside marriage during the key period 1500 1760 Women emerge as partners patrons matchmakers investors and network builders

The Collected Works of Jane Cavendish Alexandra G. Bennett,2017-08-23 The first scholarly edition of the complete works of Jane Cavendish this volume presents as complete a collection as possible of works and historical documents pertaining to a particularly compelling figure from the English Civil War These include two manuscript poem and play collections family letters to and from Jane dating from after the Civil War years and important estate papers Jane Cavendish and her nearest sister Elizabeth Brackley are the only known collaborative female dramatists of the early modern period and the co composers of the first extant stage comedy by women in English Most of Jane s extant verse and dramatic works were composed when the fighting of the English Civil War was at its most intense Her works are therefore particularly valuable to both literary and historical researchers of the period because they simultaneously play with established literary conventions and convey much first hand information about the conditions of aristocratic life during and immediately after the seventeenth century national meltdown The introduction offers as comprehensive a biography of Jane Cavendish as possible focusing primarily on Jane s childhood education and conduct during the Civil War as well as her married life after the war years Of particular interest among the documents that follow is an account book including entries from Jane s teenage years as well as her early married life it portrays vividly what a young lady of her status owned in terms of clothes and jewels as well as what a newly married woman had to acquire upon setting up a new household
