Annotation copyrighted by Book News, Inc., Portland, OR. *Selected Letters of Robert Penn Warren* Robert Penn Warren, 2013-12-16 In the last decade of his life, Robert Penn Warren remained a vibrant force in American literature, producing new works of poetry and nonfiction while also dealing courageously with the gradual decline of his health and the diminishment of his poetic powers. *Toward Sunset*, at a Great Height, 1980-1989, the sixth and final volume of the author's selected letters, provides crucial documentation of this period, containing Warren's correspondence with friends, family, fellow writers, editors, critics, and the scholars studying his works. Warren published several volumes of poetry, including *Being Here* (1980), *Rumor Verified* (1981), and *Chief Joseph of the Nez Perce* (1983), and returned to nonfiction prose with *Jefferson Davis Gets His Citizenship Back* (1980) and the memoir *Portrait of a Father* (1988). His letters reveal that he tried to begin writing a novel but was unable to make substantial progress on it, and that from 1985 on, he became increasingly dissatisfied with his new poems. Until his death at age eighty-four, however, Warren maintained an active correspondence filled with news about his writings and travels, accounts of the lives of his wife and children, and a stoic attitude about his own physical decline as well as a solicitousness regarding the health of others, such as his brother Thomas and sister Mary. He communicated with rising young scholars and encouraged younger poets he admired. *Toward Sunset*, at a Great Height, offers rich insights into the closing chapter of Robert Penn Warren's professional and personal life, making it an essential resource for understanding the full scope of the author's contribution to American letters. **Allen Tate** John V. William Terry Couch and the Politics of Academic Publishing Orvin Lee Shiflett, 2015-08-11 William Terry Couch 1901 1988 began his four decade publishing career building the University of North Carolina Press into one of the nation s leading university presses His editorial attacks on the social ills of the South earned him a reputation as a southern liberal By the 1940s his disaffection with New Deal politics turned him toward the right resulting in his 1950 firing as director of the University of Chicago Press As a conservative Couch sought books and articles that would sway general readers from what he saw as an intellectual torpor that accepted the growing role of government in American life The liberals who controlled the presses found him dogmatic and irascible When he tried to turn Collier s Encyclopedia into a journal of conservative opinion he was fired as editor in chief in 1959 He ended his career as publisher for the libertarian William Volker Fund which collapsed in the 1960s under charges of Nazism Couch was committed to publishing as a social cause and strove to disturb American complacency This is the first book length biography of Couch a publisher who brought academic scholarship to the reading public to effect social political and economic change

Superfluous Southerners John J. Langdale, III, 2012-11-01 In *Superfluous Southerners* John J. Langdale III tells the story of traditionalist conservatism and its boundaries in twentieth century America. Because this time period encompasses both the rise of the modern conservative movement and the demise of southern regional distinctiveness, it affords an ideal setting both for observing the potentiality of American conservatism and for understanding the fate of the traditionalist man of letters. Langdale uses the intellectual and literary histories of John Crowe Ransom, Donald Davidson, and Allen Tate, the three principal contributors to the Agrarian manifesto *I'll Take My Stand*, and of their three most remarkable intellectual descendants, Cleanth Brooks, Richard Weaver, and Melvin Bradford, to explore these issues. Langdale begins his study with some observations on the nature of American exceptionalism and the intrinsic barriers which it presents to the traditionalist conservative imagination. While works like Louis Menand's *The Metaphysical Club* have traced the origins of modern pragmatic liberalism during the late nineteenth century, the nature of conservative thought in postbellum America remains less completely understood. Accordingly, Langdale considers the origins of the New Humanism movement at the turn of the twentieth century, then turning to the manner in which midwesterners Irving Babbitt and Paul Elmer Moore stirred the imagination of the southern Agrarians during the 1920s. After the publication of *I'll Take My Stand* in 1930, Agrarianism splintered into three distinct modes of traditionalist conservatism: John Crowe Ransom sought refuge in literary criticism, Donald Davidson in sectionalism, and Allen Tate in an image of the religious wayfarer as a custodian of language. Langdale traces the expansion of these modes of traditionalism by succeeding generations of southerners. Following World War II, Cleanth Brooks further refined the tradition of literary criticism, while Richard Weaver elaborated the tradition of sectionalism. However, both Brooks and Weaver distinctively furthered Tate's notion that the integrity of language remained the fundamental concern of traditionalist conservatism. Langdale concludes his study with a consideration of neoconservative opposition to M. E. Bradford's proposed 1980 nomination as head of the National Endowment for the Humanities and its significance for the southern man of letters in what was becoming postmodern and postsouthern America. Though the post-World War II ascendance of neoconservatism drastically altered American intellectual history, the descendants of traditionalism remained largely superfluous to this purportedly conservative revival, which had far more in common with pragmatic liberalism than with normative conservatism.

The Patriot Poets Stephen J. Adams, 2018-11-30 Since before the Declaration of Independence, poets have shaped a collective imagination of nationhood at critical points in American history.
