1. Virus – An infectious particle consisting of genes packaged in a protein coat
2. Structure of a Virus:
 - a. Viruses are not cells
 - b. Virus Very small infectious particle consisting of nucleic acid enclosed in a protein coat and a membranous envelope
3. Viral Genome consists of...
 - a. Double or Single stranded DNA OR
 - b. Double or Single stranded RNA
 - i. The genome A single linear or circular molecule of the nucleic acid
4. Bacteriophage – Also called phages, are viruses that infect bacteria
 - a. Have an elongated capsid head that encloses their DNA
 - b. A protein tail piece attaches the phage to the host and injects the phage DNA inside
5. Lytic Cycle – A phage replicative cycle that culminates in the death of the host cell
 - a. Produces new phages and lyses (breaks open) the host's cell wall, releasing the progeny viruses
 - b. Virulent Phage - A phage that reproduces only by the lytic cycle
6. Lysogenic Cycle – Replicates the phage genome without destroying the host
 - a. The viral DNA molecule is incorporated into the host cell's chromosome
 - b. Temperate Phages – Phages that use both the lytic and lysogenic cycles
7. HIV – The retrovirus that causes AIDS (acquired immunodeficiency syndrome)
 - a. Retroviruses use reverse transcriptase to copy their RNA genome into DNA
8. Provirus – The viral DNA that is integrated into the host genome
 - a. Unlike a prophage, a provirus remains a permanent resident of the host cell
 - b. RNA polymerase transcribes the pro – viral DNA into RNA molecules
 - c. The RNA molecules function both as mRNA for synthesis of viral proteins and as genomes for new virus particles released from the cell
9. Chicken Pox – A highly contagious viral infection causing an itchy, blister-like rash on the skin
10. AIDS – A chronic, potentially life – threatening condition caused by HIV. By damaging your immune system, HIV interferes with your body's ability to fight the organisms that cause disease
11. Measles – A viral infection that's serious for small children but is easily preventable by a vaccine. The disease spreads through the air by respiratory droplets produced from coughing or sneezing
12. Influenza – A common viral infection that can be deadly, especially in high – risk groups. The flu attacks the lungs, nose, and throat
13. TB – Tuberculosis (TB) is a disease caused by bacteria called *Mycobacterium tuberculosis*. The bacteria usually attack the lungs, but they can also damage other parts of the body
14. Syphilis – A bacterial infection usually spread by sexual contact that starts as a painless sore

Dietl ,Damien Fordham, Policy makers and resource managers must make decisions that affect the resilience and sustainability of natural resources including biodiversity and ecosystem services However these decisions are often based on evidence or theory derived from highly altered systems and over short time periods of low magnitude environmental and climatic change Because natural systems change and evolve across multiple timescales from instantaneous to millennial long term understanding of how past life has responded to perturbations can inform resource managers By using these natural laboratories of the past conservation paleobiology and paleoecology provide the framework necessary to anticipate and plan for future changes The goal of this Research Topic is to heighten awareness among conservation and restoration practitioners to the value and applications of long term perspectives provided by conservation paleobiology and paleoecology Most conservation studies focus on systems already impacted by anthropogenic change these studies would benefit from paleontological data through expanded temporal scales identification of baselines and an understanding of how organisms have responded to past changes However resource management decisions rarely include input from paleontologists and paleoecological research is rarely incorporated into conservation decision making We seek to bridge this research implementation gap by highlighting the application of paleoecological data to issues such as biodiversity dynamics extinction risks and resilience to perturbations among other topics We hope to foster new cross disciplinary synergies by encouraging conservation scientists and managers to collaborate with paleontologists to improve conservation decision making and by increasing awareness among paleontologists to the needs of the resource management community This Research Topic will provide a forum for both the paleontological and resource management communities to exchange ideas that will enhance restoration and conservation decision making We invite papers on conceptual advances reviews of specific topics to guide efforts in research or practice case studies of successful applications articles describing datasets with applied value and
