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Resurrecting the Past Sarah Griswold, 2025-09-15 In *Resurrecting the Past* Sarah Griswold shows how the Levant became a crucial front in a post 1918 fight over the French past a contingent and contradictory but always hard charging struggle over a forgotten heritage mandate Many scholars clergy pundits politicians and investors perceived the moment Allied forces entered Jerusalem in December 1917 to be a once in a lifetime opportunity to expand French influence evoking the vision of a new colony in the territory a French Levant But what transpired for the French state in the Levant after World War I and why does that ill conceived venture still matter today *Resurrecting the Past* investigates how heritage politics led to a new form of empire a French mandate for Syria and Lebanon and with it a tide of regional and international critique Against such opposition the heritage mandate leaned heavily on spectacle and science generating a sprawling set of sites and objects Ottoman mansions crusader castles Umayyad mosques Roman arches buried synagogues and Sumerian ziggurats As Griswold traces how French heritage efforts cycled through multiple ideal pasts in the Levant from 1918 to 1946 she reveals how each one though grounded in realities also complicated those constructs and the work of French heritage makers *Resurrecting the Past* offers a parable of how efforts in heritage politics aimed to construct a union of ideologies and objects deemed the best past for France s uncertain future but struggled as much as they succeeded Eventually those same heritage politics ironically helped officials justify the end of the French Levant **Northrop Frye's Lectures** Robert D.

Charles Olson's Reading Ralph Maud, 1996 In this narrative account of the life and work of Charles Olson Ralph Maud focuses on what the poet read as a basis for understanding the work he produced To an extraordinary degree Olson's reading and life were coextensive according to Maud who notes that Olson saw his written output over his lifetime as a total cosmology An individual who rarely traveled this major American poet explored the world and its history as well as the furthest reaches of the thought of his day through books Maud builds upon George Butterick's annotated listing of Olson's library bought by the University of Connecticut after the poet's death in 1970 The present volume however adds categories of books Butterick deliberately omitted Olson's childhood books and poetry by his own contemporaries Linking Olson's books to his intellectual and poetic development at each stage of his career Maud reveals such little known but important connections as the contracted book project Operation Red White and Black and Olson's plan for the long poem West two unrealized projects much later shaped into The Maximus Poems Maud also outlines the surprisingly multiple role of the painter Corrado Cagli who brought home to Olson the significance of the Holocaust and introduced him both to the Tarot and to the theories of non Euclidean geometry that Olson variously incorporated into his poems and essays In discussing Olson's relationship to Ezra Pound Maud defines in some detail what Olson gained from Pound and what he repudiated Maud refutes the notion that Olson's intellectual and creative powers declined during the last

years of his life demonstrating that during these years Olson developed his Jungian interest his attention to early Greek thought and a new concern for Northern mythology This chronicle of Olson s reading from childhood to deathbed constitutes a critical biography of the larger than life author of *Call Me Ishmael* and *The Maximus Poems* No modern poet is more revealed in his sources than Olson Maud s comprehensive and complete study provides a basis for new and fresh modes of thinking about Olson s great achievement

A Psychological Interpretation of Ruth Yehezkel Kluger, 1999 The biblical Book of Ruth is a love story apparently personal and simple of love between women and between man and woman told in poetic imagery and style Barely hiding within this immediate beauty are the archetypal depths which reveal nothing less than the eternal mystery of a love which brings about redemption and individuation both personal and transcendent human and divine Dr Kluger wrote the original interpretation as part of the requirements of the first graduating class of the Jung Institute in Zurich He later updated his work but the thesis remains the same the return of the feminine principle in the Bible To this end he examines the fate and role of the feminine as she travels from ancient times through various goddesses to the person of Ruth and her destiny as restoring the original totality of masculine and feminine in equal interacting balance In counterpoint to the scholarly style of her father while in unison with his interpretations Nomi Kluger Nash has written a woman's subjective reactions to the story of Ruth Naomi and Orpah To this associative style she brings further amplifications from Kabbalah into the meaning of these women who carry aspects both light and dark of the Shekhinah the feminine presence of God

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
