Earth is part of the Solar System

How Earth moves

Even though it might look still, Earth is always moving. It spins on an invisible line called its axis, which goes from the North Pole to the South Pole. This spinning makes day and night on different parts of Earth from sunlight or darkness, depending on their position in relation to the Sun. It takes about 24 hours for Earth to complete one rotation.

How Earth orbits

A year on Earth is the time it takes for Earth to go all the way around the Sun. Earth moves in an oval shaped path, with the Sun in the centre of the oval. This means that the distance between Earth and the Sun changes throughout the year.

Seasons on Earth

Earth moving around the Sun also causes the four seasons: spring, summer, autumn and winter. Earth is tilted on its axis, which means different parts of the planet get different amounts of sunlight during the year. When one part of Earth is tilted towards the Sun, it's summer there. When it's tilted away, it's winter. Spring and autumn happen in between, when Earth is moving between summer and winter.
