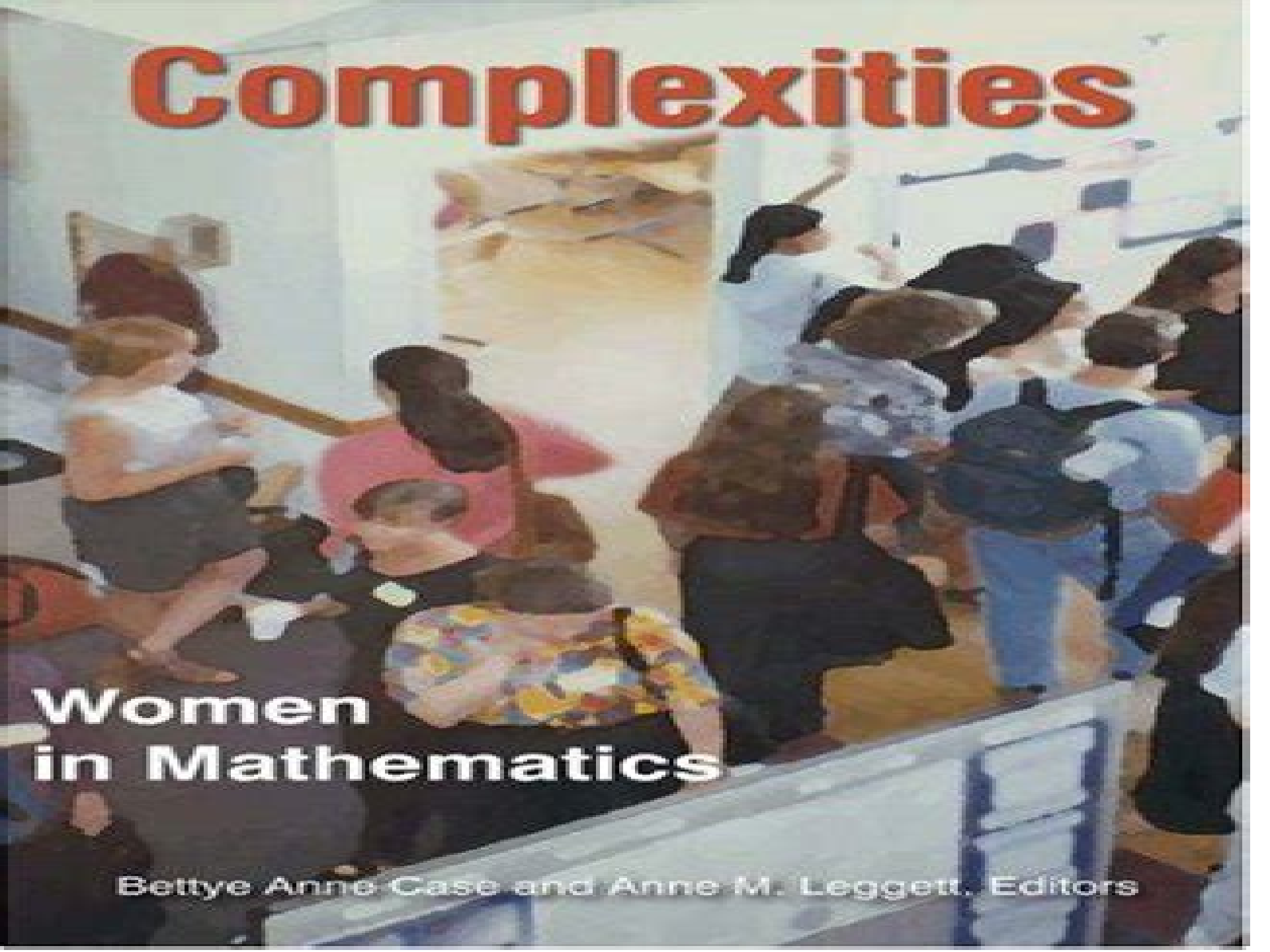


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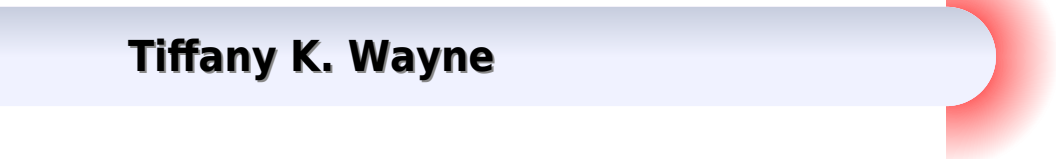

Praeger,Betül Tanbay,2019-11-16 The first World Meeting for Women in Mathematics WM 2 was a satellite event of the International Congress of Mathematicians ICM 2018 in Rio de Janeiro With a focus on Latin America the first WM 2 brought together mathematicians from all over the world to celebrate women mathematicians and also to reflect on gender issues in mathematics challenges initiatives and perspectives for the future Its activities were complemented by a panel discussion organized by the Committee for Women in Mathematics CWM of the International Mathematical Union IMU inside the ICM 2018 entitled The gender gap in mathematical and natural sciences from a historical perspective This historical proceedings book organized by CWM in coordination with the Association for Women in Mathematics records the first WM 2 and the CWM panel discussion at ICM 2018 The first part of the volume includes a report of activities with pictures of the first WM 2 and a tribute to Maryam Mirzakhani the first woman to be awarded the Fields medal It also comprises survey research papers from invited lecturers which provide panoramic views of different fields in pure and applied mathematics The second part of the book contains articles from the panelists of the CWM panel discussion which consider the historical context of the gender gap in mathematics It includes an analysis of women lecturers in the ICM since its inception This book is dedicated to the memory of Maryam Mirzakhani

The authors used various critical theories to situate and make visible the lives of women of color in such disciplines and workplace contexts like mathematics, science, engineering, NASA, academia, government agencies, and others. They skillfully centered women and their experiences at the intersection of their identity dimensions of race, class, gender, and their respective discipline. While the disciplines and career contexts vary, the oppression, alienation, and social inequities were common realities for all. Despite the challenges, the women were resilient and persevered with tenacity, a strong sense of self as a person of color, and reliance on family, community, mentors, and spirituality. While we celebrated the successes, it is critical that organizational leaders, whether in education or other workplace settings, draw from narratives and counter narratives of these women to improve the organizational climate where individuals can thrive despite their racial, class, and gender identity. This book will assist educational communities, professional communities, and families to understand their roles and responsibilities in increasing the number of women of color in STEM.

Change Is Possible Patricia C. Kenschaft, 2005

Based on dozens of interviews and extensive historical research and spiced with interesting photographs, this entertaining book relates stories about mathematicians who have defied stereotypes. There are five chapters about women that provide insight into the nineteenth and the mid twentieth century, the early 1970s, the early 1990s, and 2004. Activists in many fields will take heart at the progress made during that time. The author documents the rudimentary struggles to become professionals, being married without entirely giving up a career, organizing to eliminate flagrant discrimination, improving the daily treatment of women in the professional community, and the widespread efforts toward true equality. The stories of African Americans in mathematics include the efforts of Benjamin Banneker, an eighteenth century American who had three

grandparents born in Africa He helped design Washington DC and made the computations for almanacs that succeeded Benjamin Franklin s There are stories about African American mathematicians who were students and faculty in late nineteenth century colleges and accounts of several efforts to integrate the mathematical community in the mid twentieth century These stories indicate that though some efforts were more successful than others all of them were difficult The book concludes with a happier chapter about five black mathematicians in the early twenty first century The book also includes five interviews with leading Latin American mathematicians along with the results of a survey of Latino research mathematicians in the Southwest The author is a skilled story teller with good stories to tell This book is a page turner that all mathematicians as well as others concerned with equality should read It is a work of great interest and an enjoyable read
