Cisatracurium Nimbex 	Neuromuscular Blocking agent	20mg/200ml NS, D5W	1mg/kg/min (initial muscle relaxation) * Establish a baseline T10 prior to initiating this medication.	After effectively blocked, decrease to 1-2mg/kg/min Monitor T10 twitches with a nerve stimulator Q4hr Dose range: 0.5 – 10mg/kg/min Average dose: 1mg/kg/min	Relax skeletal muscles during mechanical ventilation, metabolized by a process that mostly bypasses the kidney and liver.	- To be ONLY used on mechanically ventilated pt's - Has no analgesic properties. - Side effects: Bradycardia, hypotension.

Dexmedetomidine Precedex 	Alpha-2 Adrenergic Agonist Sedative	200mcg/50ml NS	0.2 mcg/kg/hr Do Not Bolus	Main: 0.2 – 1.4 mcg/kg/hr Titrate infusion by increments 0.1mcg/kg/hr Q15mins	Sedation for mechanically ventilated and non intubated pt's	- Consider dose reduction for hepatic or renal impairment - Bradycardia and Hypotension
Diltiazem Cardizem 	Antihypertensive Calcium Channel Blocker	0.5mg/25ml in 100ml D5W or NS for 0.1 solution	Bolus: 0.15mg/kg over 1min	If no effect in 15min, bolus with 0.15mg/kg over 1min.
