Disalienation Camille Robcis, 2021-05-03 From 1940 to 1945 forty thousand patients died in French psychiatric hospitals. The Vichy regime's soft extermination let patients die of cold starvation or lack of care. But in Saint Alban sur Limagnole, a small village in central France, one psychiatric hospital attempted to resist. Hoarding food with the help of the local population, the staff not only worked to keep patients alive but began to rethink the practical and theoretical bases of psychiatric care. The movement that began at Saint Alban came to be known as institutional psychotherapy and would go on to have a profound influence on postwar French thought. In *Disalienation*, Camille Robcis grapples with the historical, intellectual, and psychiatric meaning of the ethics articulated at Saint Alban by exploring the movement's key thinkers, including Franois Tosquelles, Frantz Fanon, Félix Guattari, and Michel Foucault. Anchored in the history of one hospital, Robcis's study draws on a wide geographic context: revolutionary Spain, occupied France, colonial Algeria, and beyond, and charts the movement's place within a broad political-economic landscape from fascism to Stalinism to postwar capitalism.

While psychoanalytic scholarship has typically focused on its intellectual, social, and political effects outside of the clinic, this interdisciplinary book combines history with feminist and decolonial social theory to recast the clinic as a necessarily politicized space. Challenging common assumptions that psychoanalytic practice is or should be neutral, apolitical, and objective, *The Political Clinic* also considers what progressive clinical praxis can offer today.

Quotations from Chairman Mao Tse tung is a book of statements from speeches and writings by Mao Zedong Mao Tse tung the former Chairman of the Communist Party of China published from 1964 to about 1976 and widely distributed during the Cultural Revolution The most popular versions were printed in small sizes that could be easily carried and were bound in bright red covers becoming commonly known in the West as the Little Red Book Quotations from Chairman Mao Tse tung was originally compiled by an office of the PLA Daily People s Liberation Army Daily as an inspirational political and military document The initial publication covered 23 topics with 200 selected quotations by the Chairman of the Chinese Communist Party and was entitled 200 Quotations from Chairman Mao It was first given to delegates of a conference on 5 January 1964 who were asked to comment on it In response to the views of the deputies and compilers of the book the work was expanded to address 25 topics with 267 quotations and the title was changed simply to Quotations from Chairman Mao Tse Tung
