Conscience Conviction Case Civil Disobedience:

Beyond Duty Thomas E. Hill Jr., 2021-10-14 *Beyond Duty* presents a new collection of essays on Kantian moral theory and practical ethics from a distinguished philosopher known for making Kantian ethics accessible and relevant to contemporary problems. With a new emphasis on ideals beyond the strictest requirements of moral duty, Thomas E. Hill Jr. expands the core aspects of Kantian ethics and offers a broader perspective on familiar moral problems. Some essays explain Kantian concepts while others review work of leading contemporary philosophers or raise challenging ethical questions for more general audiences. Crucially, Hill develops an ethical ideal of appreciation of people and their lives. Distinguished from both respect and beneficence, this has important implications about how we should think about close personal relationships such as friendships, families, and relationships with people with disabilities. Part I focuses on Kantian moral theory. Topics include the structure of Kant's argument in the *Groundwork*, his idea of imperfect duties to oneself, autonomy and human dignity. Rawls' constructivism is defended against O'Neill's objections, and Kantian ethics is defended against the charge of utopian thinking. Part II focuses on practical ethics, including the ethics of suicide, philanthropy, conscientious objection, and tragic choices when it seems that every alternative offends against human dignity. An essay on moral education contrasts Kantian and Rawlsian perspectives; another traces the role of self-respect in Rawls' theory of justice and contrasts a Kantian conception. The volume concludes with two essays that develop and illustrate the ideal of appreciation.

Modes of Protest And Resistance Margaret Betz, 2023-11-28 This book presents a philosophical analysis of the different forms of political resistance and protest. It explores the normative space of resistance that is beyond self-defense and civil disobedience and proposes the concept of resistance violence as a separate and special normative category. Instances that fall under this category can be accordingly justified even if they prove to be practically ineffective by appealing to their role in preserving or upholding the dignity of the resisters or those who they aim to protect. Margaret Betz draws from important and interesting historical examples to establish the concept and proposes to apply it to better understand contemporary struggles against injustice.

A New Theory of Conscientious Objection in Medicine Robert F. Card, 2020-04-19 This book argues that a conscientiously objecting medical professional should receive an exemption only if the grounds of an objector's refusal are reasonable. It defends a detailed contextual account of public reasonability suited for healthcare which builds from the overarching concept of Rawlsian public reason. The author analyzes the main competing positions and maintains that these other views fail precisely due to their systematic inattention to the grounding reasons behind a conscientious objection. He argues that any such view is plausible to the extent that it mimics the reason-giving requirement for conscience objections defended in this work. Only reasonable objections can defeat the prior professional obligation to assign primacy to patient well-being; therefore, one who refuses a patient's request for a legally available medically indicated and safe service must be able to explain the grounds of their objection in terms understandable to other citizens within the public institutional

structure of medicine The book further offers a novel policy proposal to deploy the Reasonability View establishing conscientious objector status in medicine It concludes that the Reasonability View is a viable and attractive position in this debate A New Theory of Conscientious Objection in Medicine Justification and Reasonability will be of interest to researchers and advanced students working in bioethics medical ethics and philosophy of medicine as well as thinkers interested in the intersections between law medical humanities and philosophy

Whistleblowing Daniele Santoro, Manohar Kumar, 2018-08-22 Whistleblowing is the public disclosure of information with the purpose of revealing wrongdoings and abuses of power that harm the public interest This book presents a comprehensive theory of whistleblowing it defines the concept reconstructs its origins discusses it within the current ethical debate and elaborates a justification of unauthorized disclosures Its normative proposal is based on three criteria of permissibility the communicative constraints the intent and the public interest conditions The book distinguishes between two forms of whistleblowing civic and political showing how they apply in the contexts of corruption and government secrecy The book articulates a conception of public interest as a claim concerning the presumptive interest of the public It argues that public interest is defined in opposition to corporate powers and its core content identified by the rights that are all purposive for the distribution of social benefits A crucial part of the proposal is dedicated to the impact of security policies and government secrecy on civil liberties It argues that unrestrained secrecy limits the epistemic entitlement of citizens to know under which conditions their rights are limited by security policies and corporate interests When citizens are denied the right to assess when these policies are prejudicial to their freedoms whistleblowing represents a legitimate form of political agency that safeguards the fundamental rights of citizens against the threat of unrestrained secrecy by government power Finally the book contributes to shifting the attention of democratic theory from the procedures of consent formation to the mechanisms that guarantee the expression of dissent It argues that whistleblowing is a distinctive form of civil dissent that contributes to the demands of institutional transparency in constitutional democracies and explores the idea that the way institutions are responsive to dissent determines the robustness of democracy and ultimately its legitimacy What place dissenters have within a society whether they enjoy personal safety legal protection and safe channels for their disclosure are hallmarks of a good democracy and of its sense of justice
