Reynolds, 2001-10-18 The use of wildlife for food and other human needs poses one of the greatest threats to the conservation of biodiversity Wildlife exploitation is also critically important to many people from a variety of cultures for subsistence and commerce This book brings together international experts to examine interactions between the biology of wildlife and the divergent goals of people involved in hunting fishing gathering and culling wildlife Reviews of theory show how sustainable exploitation is tied to the study of population dynamics with direct links to reproductive rates life histories behaviour and ecology As such theory is rarely put into practice to achieve sustainable use and effective conservation Conservation of Exploited Species explores the many reasons for this failure and considers remedies to tackle them including scientific issues such as how to incorporate uncertainty into estimations as well as social and political problems that stem from conflicting goals in exploitation

Biological Invasions Belowground: Earthworms as Invasive Species Paul F. Hendrix, 2008-09-01 The most conspicuous biological invasions in terrestrial ecosystems have been by exotic plants insects and vertebrates Less conspicuous but possibly of equal importance are invasions by soil invertebrates which are occurring literally beneath our feet Familiar examples include the South American fire ant *Solenopsis invicta* which has invaded North America and Australia and the New Zealand flatworm *Arthurdendyus triangulatus* which has become wide spread in the United Kingdom both have caused considerable ecological and economic damage There is now evidence that exotic earthworm invasions are increasing world wide and may be having significant impacts on soil processes and plant communities in some regions Much remains to be learned about these cryptic biological invasions The papers in this book are based on efforts by an international group of soil ecologists to assess the biological and ecological mechanisms of earthworm invasions their geographic extent and impacts on terrestrial ecosystems and possible means by which earthworm invasions might be mitigated

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
