complement Rollyson's *Documentary Film: A Primer*. The films discussed in this volume include *Zelig*, the Lumiere brothers documentaries *Nanook of the North*, *The Man With a Movie Camera*, *Triumph of the Will*, *Olympia*, *The Wonderful Horrible Life of Leni Riefenstahl*, *Why We Fight*, *Fires Were Started*, and several Jill Craigie films including an extended discussion of *Two Hours From London*, her controversial examination of the Balkan wars and the siege of Dubrovnik. What sets this text apart from other studies of documentary is that it includes a wide array of student comments on the films and reviews very much centered in discussions of the documentary tradition. In this same vein, Rollyson has included his essay *Jill Craigie and the Documentary Tradition*, exploring her relationship with John Grierson and other prominent documentary filmmakers. This dialogic text captures some of the actual give and take of the classroom and the range of opinion that even the best critics cannot convey. What should emerge from the reading of these comments are the different voices/mindsets through which the films are viewed.

Inuit Women Janet Mancini Billson, Kyra Mancini, 2007. *Inuit Women* is the definitive study of the Inuit during a time of rapid change. Based on fourteen years of research and fieldwork, this analysis focuses on the challenges facing Inuit women as they enter the twenty-first century. Written shortly after the creation of Nunavut, a new province carved out of traditional Inuit homelands in the Canadian North, this compelling book combines conclusions drawn from the authors' ethnographic research with the stories of Inuit women and men told in their own words. In addition to their presentation of the personal portraits and voices of many Inuit respondents, Janet Mancini Billson and Kyra Mancini explore global issues: the impact of rapid social change and Canadian resettlement policy on Inuit culture; women's roles in society and gender relations in Baffin Island in the Eastern Arctic. They also include an extensive section on how the newly created territory of Nunavut is impacting the lives of Inuit women and their families. Working from a research approach grounded in feminist theory, the authors involve their Inuit interviewees as full participants in the process. This book stands alone in its attention to Inuit women's issues and lives and should be read by everyone interested in gender relations, development, modernization, globalization, and Inuit culture.

Exploring Atlantic Transitions Peter Edward Pope, Shannon Lewis-Simpson, 2013. Current approaches to the archaeological understanding of permanence and transience in the early modern period: Can we approach European expansion to the Americas and elsewhere without colonial triumphalism? A research strategy which automatically treats early establishments overseas as embryonic colonies produces predictable results in retrospect: some were, some were not. The approach reflected in the essays collected here does not exclude an interest in colonialism as an enduring practice, but the focus of the volume is population mobility and stability. Post-medieval archaeology has much to contribute to our understanding of the gradual drift of ordinary people, the cast of thousands, anonymous or almost forgotten, behind the famous names of history. The main concern of the articles here is the post-medieval expansion of the English-speaking world to North America, particularly Newfoundland and the Chesapeake, but the volume includes perspectives on Ireland and New France also. While most attend to the movement of Europeans, interactions with Native peoples using the Labrador Inuit as a case

Norway Norse Greenland was the stepping stone for the Europeans who first discovered America and settled briefly in Newfoundland ca AD 1000 The community had a global significance which surpassed its modest size In the last decades scholars have been nearly unanimous in emphasising that long term climatic and environmental changes created a situation where Norse agriculture was no longer sustainable and the community was ruined A secondary hypothesis has focused on ethnic confrontations between Norse peasants and Inuit hunters In the last decades ethnic violence has been on the rise in Eastern Europe the Middle East and parts of Africa In some cases it has degenerated into ethnic cleansing This has strengthened the interest in ethnic violence in past societies Challenging traditional hypotheses is a source of progress in all science The present book does this on the basis of relevant written and archaeological material respecting the methodology of both sciences
