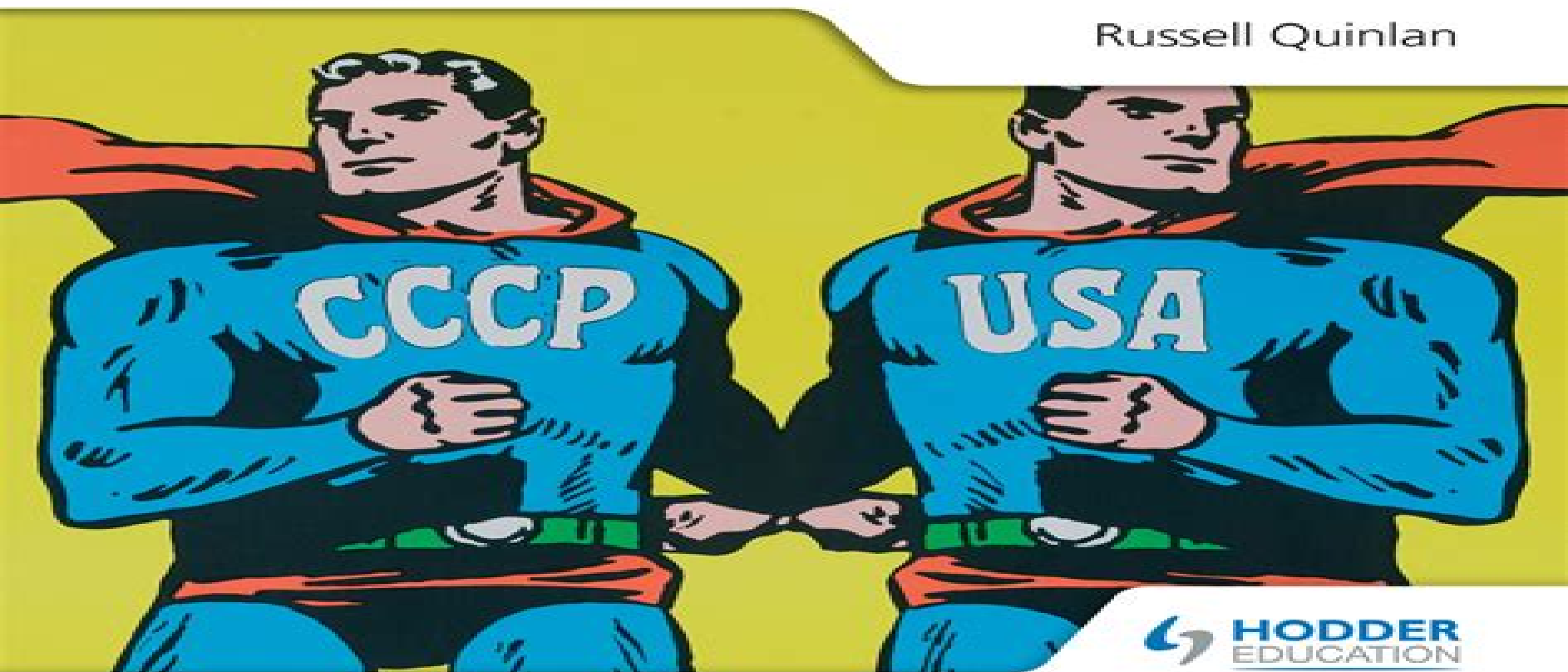

China's rapid economic ascent, coupled with its asymmetrical influence with its trading partners, intensified anxieties as China closed the gap in capabilities with the United States, further exacerbating international insecurities. Paradoxically, this situation has arisen due to China's remarkable success in becoming a *de facto* rather than *de jure* member of the San Francisco system in the second half of the Cold War through a very successful

adaptation of capitalist reforms The adjustments brought about by the Quad countries are in reality realpolitik manoeuvres dressed in Cold War rhetoric in a collective effort to isolate China and diminish its influence within the San Francisco system and the wider region Unless the Quad countries can recalibrate their relations and adapt to a significantly more influential China the region's insecurities are likely to intensify as the conditions fueling nationalisms persist and globalization becomes increasingly bifurcated leading to a possible collapse of the San Francisco system itself This book takes a no holds barred approach in challenging conventional wisdoms and policy centric narratives and puts forth a forwarding looking argument that community building development and peace should remain the dominant goals for all regional countries going forward
