- Succession: primary succession, secondary succession
- Disturbance: natural (fire, flood), human (logging, agriculture)
- Resilience: ability to recover from disturbance
- Stability: resistance to change

1. An ecosystem's composition and structure is determined by disturbance.
2. Disturbance is a natural event that changes an ecosystem's structure and composition.
3. The study of how things change over time is called ecology.
4. Ecosystems that have been disturbed and are in the process of recovering are called secondary succession.
