Conversations with James Baldwin James Baldwin, 1989 This book collects interview and conversations which contribute substantially to an understanding and clarification of James Baldwin's personality and perspective his interests and achievements The collection also represents a kind of companion piece to the earlier dialogues *A Rap on Race* with Margaret Mead and *A Dialogue with Nikki Giovanni* Introduction *James Baldwin: The Last Interview* James Baldwin, 2014-12-02 Never before available the unexpurgated last interview with James Baldwin I was not born to be what someone said I was I was not born to be defined by someone else but by myself and myself only When in the fall of 1987 the poet Quincy Troupe traveled to the south of France to interview James Baldwin Baldwin's brother David told him to ask Baldwin about everything Baldwin was critically ill and David knew that this might be the writer's last chance to speak at length about his life and work The result is one of the most eloquent and revelatory interviews of Baldwin's career a conversation that ranges widely over such topics as his childhood in Harlem his close friendship with Miles Davis his relationship with writers like Toni Morrison and Richard Wright his years in France and his ever incisive thoughts on the history of race relations and the African American experience Also collected here are significant interviews from other moments in Baldwin's life including an in depth interview conducted by Studs Terkel shortly after the publication of *Nobody Knows My Name* These interviews showcase above all Baldwin's fearlessness and integrity as a writer thinker and individual as well as the profound struggles he faced along the way *The Cambridge Companion to James Baldwin* Michele Elam, 2015-04-20 This Companion offers fresh insight into the art and politics of James Baldwin one of the most important writers and provocative cultural critics of the twentieth century Black gay and gifted he was hailed as a spokesman for the race although he personally and controversially eschewed titles and classifications of all kinds Individual essays examine his classic novels and nonfiction as well as his work across lesser examined domains poetry music theatre sermon photo text children's literature public media comedy and artistic collaboration In doing so *The Cambridge Companion to James Baldwin* captures the power and influence of his work during the civil rights era as well as his relevance in the post race transnational twenty first century when his prescient questioning of the boundaries of race sex love leadership and country assume new urgency *Conversations with Audre Lorde* Audre Lorde, 2004 Audre Lorde 1934 1992 the author of eleven books of poetry described herself as a Black feminist lesbian poet warrior mother but she added that this phrase was inadequate in capturing her full identity The interviews in this collection portray the many additional sides of the Harlem born author and activist She was also a rebellious child of Caribbean parents a mastectomy patient a blue collar worker a college professor a student of African mythology an experimental autobiographer in her book titled *Zami* a critic of imperialism and a charismatic orator Despite her intense engagement with the major social movements of her time Lorde told interviewers that she was always an outsider a position of weakness and of strength Most of her schoolmates were white She married a white legal aid attorney

and after their divorce she was the partner of a white psychologist for many years These intimate alliances with whites caused some African Americans of both genders to question the depth of her solidarity Lorde expressed distrust of some white feminists and charged that they lacked real understanding of African American struggles Writing proved to be her powerful weapon against injustice Painfully aware that differences could provoke prejudice and violence she promoted the bridging of barriers These interviews reveal the sense of displacement that made Lorde a champion of the outcast and the forgotten whether in New York Mississippi Berlin or Soweto

Talking at the Gates James Campbell, 2021-02-23 An intimate portrait of Baldwin's mythic life James Baldwin was one of the most incisive and influential American writers of the twentieth century Active in the civil rights movement and open about his homosexuality Baldwin was celebrated for eloquent analyses of social unrest in his essays and for daring portrayals of sexuality and interracial relationships in his fiction By the time of his death in 1987 both his fiction and nonfiction works had achieved the status of modern classics James Campbell knew James Baldwin for the last ten years of Baldwin's life For *Talking at the Gates* Campbell interviewed many of Baldwin's friends and professional associates and examined several hundred pages of correspondence Campbell was the first biographer to obtain access to the large file that the FBI and other agencies had compiled on the writer Examining Baldwin's turbulent relationships with Norman Mailer Richard Wright Marlon Brando Martin Luther King Jr and others this candid and original account portrays the life and work of a writer who held to the principle that the unexamined life is not worth living This new edition features a fresh introduction addressing recent developments in Baldwin's reputation and his return to a position he occupied in the early 1960s when *Life* magazine called him the monarch of the current literary jungle It also contains a previously unpublished interview with Norman Mailer about Baldwin which Campbell conducted in 1987

Remembering Medgar Evers Minrose Gwin, 2013-02-25 As the first NAACP field secretary for Mississippi Medgar Wiley Evers put his life on the line to investigate racial crimes including Emmett Till's murder and to organize boycotts and voter registration drives On June 12 1963 he was shot in the back by white supremacist Byron De La Beckwith as the civil rights leader unloaded a stack of Jim Crow Must Go T-shirts in his own driveway His was the first assassination of a high ranking public figure in the civil rights movement While Evers's death ushered in a decade of political assassinations and ignited a powder keg of racial unrest nationwide his life of service and courage has largely been consigned to the periphery of U.S. and civil rights history In her compelling study of collective memory and artistic production

Remembering Medgar Evers Minrose Gwin engages the powerful body of work that has emerged in response to Evers's life and death: fiction, poetry, memoir, drama, and songs from James Baldwin, Margaret Walker, Eudora Welty, Lucille Clifton, Bob Dylan, and Willie Morris, among others. Gwin examines local news accounts about Evers, 1960s gospel and protest music, as well as contemporary hip hop, the haunting poems of Frank X Walker, and contemporary fiction such as *The Help* and Gwin's own novel *The Queen of Palmyra*. In this study, Evers springs to life as a leader of plural singularity who modeled for southern African Americans a new form of cultural identity that both drew from the past and broke from it, to quote Gwendolyn Brooks: "He leaned across tomorrow / Fifty years after his untimely death / Evers still casts a long shadow." In her examination of the body of work he has inspired, Gwin probes wide-ranging questions about collective memory and art as instruments of social justice. Honorable Mention Recipient of the Modern Language Association Prize for Collaborative Bibliographical or Archival Scholarship. Spanning from the debut of *A Raisin in the Sun* on Broadway in 1959 to her early death from cancer in January 1965, Lorraine Hansberry's short stint in the public eye changed the landscape of American theater. With *A Raisin in the Sun*, Hansberry (1930-1965) became both the first African American woman to have a play produced on Broadway and the first to win the prestigious New York Drama Critics Circle Award. Resonating deeply with the aims of the civil rights movement, *Raisin* also ushered in a new era of Black representation on the stage and screen, displacing the cartoonish stereotypes that were the remnants of blackface minstrelsy in favor of complex, three-dimensional portrayals of Black characters and Black life. Hansberry's public discourse in the aftermath of *Raisin*'s success also disrupted mainstream critical tendencies to diminish the work of Black artists, helping pave the way for future work by Black playwrights. *Conversations with Lorraine Hansberry* is the first volume to collect all of her substantive interviews in one place, including many radio and television interviews that have never before appeared in print. The twenty-one pieces collected here, ranging from just before the Broadway premiere of *A Raisin in the Sun* to less than six months before Hansberry's death, offer an incredible window into Hansberry's aesthetic and political thought. In these conversations, Hansberry explores many of the questions most often put to Black writers of the mid-twentieth century, including everything from her thinking about the relationship between art and protest, universality and particularity, and realism and naturalism to her sense of the relationship between Black intellectuals and the Black masses, integration and Black Nationalism, and African American and Pan African liberation. Recent years have brought public mourning to the heart of American politics, as exemplified by the spread and power of the Black Lives Matter movement, which has gained force through its identification of pervasive social injustices with individual losses. The deaths of Sandra Bland, Michael Brown, Freddie Gray, Trayvon Martin,

Tamir Rice Walter Scott and so many others have brought private grief into the public sphere The rhetoric and iconography of mourning has been noteworthy in Black Lives Matter protests but David W McIvor believes that we have paid too little attention to the nature of social mourning its relationship to private grief its practices and its pathologies and democratic possibilities In *Mourning in America* McIvor addresses significant and urgent questions about how citizens can mourn traumatic events and enduring injustices in their communities McIvor offers a framework for analyzing the politics of mourning drawing from psychoanalysis Greek tragedy and scholarly discourses on truth and reconciliation *Mourning in America* connects these literatures to ongoing activism surrounding racial injustice and it contextualizes Black Lives Matter in the broader politics of grief and recognition McIvor also examines recent grassroots organized truth and reconciliation processes such as the Greensboro Truth and Reconciliation Commission 2004 2006 which provided a public examination of the Greensboro Massacre of 1979 a deadly incident involving local members of the Communist Workers Party and the Ku Klux Klan
