The Intimate Sex Lives of Famous People Irving Wallace, Amy Wallace, David Wallechinsky, Sylvia Wallace, 2008 The Wallace family goes back to their 1981 classic and brings it bang up to date with acerbic sophisticated behind the curtains entries on Tupac Shakur Princess Diana Kurt Cobain Malcolm X Jim Morrison and others who have impacted popular culture 15 new entries enhance this revised classic illustrated historical romp **Notable American Women** Susan Ware, 2004 This latest volume brings the project up to date with entries on almost 500 women whose death dates fall between 1976 and 1999 You will find here stars of the golden ages of radio film dance and television scientists and scholars civil rights activists and religious leaders Native American craftspeople and world renowned artists For each subject the volume offers a biographical essay by a distinguished authority that integrates the woman s personal life with her professional achievements set in the context of larger historical developments **Ferocious Ambition** Robert Dance, 2023-10-12 Robert Dance s new evaluation of Joan Crawford looks at her entire career and while not ignoring her early years and tempestuous personal life focuses squarely on her achievements as an actress and as a woman who mastered the studio system with a rare combination of grit determination beauty and talent Crawford s remarkable forty five year motion picture career is one of the industry s longest Signing her first contract in 1925 she was crowned an MGM star four years later and by the mid 1930s was the most popular actress in America In the early 1940s Crawford s risky decision to move to Warner Bros was rewarded with an Oscar for Mildred Pierce This triumph launched a series of film noir classics In her fourth decade she teamed with rival Bette Davis in *Whatever Happened to Baby Jane* proving that Crawford whose career had begun by defining big screen glamour had matured into a superb dramatic actress Her last film was released in 1970 and two years later she made a final television appearance forty seven years after walking through the MGM gate for the first time Crawford made a successful transition into business during her later years notably in her long association with Pepsi Cola as a board member and the brand s leading ambassador Overlooked in previous biographies has been Crawford s fierce resolve in creating and then maintaining her star persona She let neither her age nor the passing of time block her unrivaled ambition and she continually reimagined herself noting once that for the right part she would play Wally Beery s grandmother But she was always the consummate star and at the time of her death in 1977 she was a motion picture legend and a twentieth century icon **Conversations with Terrence McNally** Raymond-Jean Frontain, 2023-01-27 Arriving in New York at the tail end of what has been termed the Golden Age of Broadway and the start of the Off Broadway theater movement Terrence McNally 1938 2020 first established himself as a dramatist of the absurd and a biting social critic He quickly recognized however that one is more

likely to change people's minds by first changing their hearts and in outrageous farces like *The Ritz* and *It's Only a Play* began using humor more broadly to challenge social biases. By the mid 1980s as the emerging AIDS pandemic called into question America's treatment of persons isolated by suffering and sickness he became the theater's great poet of compassion dramatizing the urgent need of human connection and the consequences when such connections do not take place.

Conversations with Terrence McNally collects nineteen interviews with the celebrated playwright. In these interviews one hears McNally reflect on theater as the most collaborative of the arts, the economic pressures that drive the theater industry, the unique values of music and dance and the changes in American theater over McNally's fifty plus year career. The winner of four competitive Tony Awards as the author of *The Best Play*, *Love Valour Compassion* and *Master Class* and author of the book for the Best Musical *Kiss of the Spider Woman* and *Ragtime*, McNally holds the distinction of being one of the few writers for the American theater who excelled in straight drama as well as musical comedy. In addition his canon extends to opera; his collaboration with composer Jake Heggie *Dead Man Walking* has proven the most successful new American opera of the last twenty five years.

In between there were four children including actress Isabella Rossellini, three husbands and passionate affairs with war photographer Robert Capa, *Wizard of Oz* director Victor Fleming and *Spellbound* co star Gregory Peck. She was perhaps the most international star in the history of entertainment and without a doubt one of the most misunderstood. In a career that spanned six decades, two Academy Awards and ten Oscar nominations, Bette Davis became one of the greatest screen legends of all time. But as her epitaph says, She did it the hard way. She was in constant battles with co stars, directors and studios and struggled with addictions to alcohol and cigarettes. She had four stormy marriages and even her three children brought pain and controversy. One wrote a scathing tell all book, another had a severe mental disability and a third was the subject of a prolonged custody battle. But in her iconic film roles Davis transcended her troubles to leave an indelible mark on American cinema. Possessing none of the glamorous beauty of Greta Garbo, she had something more powerful and lasting: a restless incandescent energy that made her mesmerizing to watch on the big screen. Katharine Hepburn was far more than an iconic movie star who won four Academy Awards for best actress and made classic films that still rank among the greatest of all time. She also exerted a unique influence on American popular culture, challenging rigid assumptions about how women should behave and almost single handedly gave them permission to wear pants. The list of adjectives used to describe Hepburn—bold, stubborn, witty, beautiful—only begin to hint at the complex woman who entranced audiences around the world.

So here is the full epic story of the patron saint of the independent American female as one critic described her Hepburn always lived life strictly on her own terms And oh what a life it was For a time Elizabeth Taylor was the world s biggest star but it was her off screen life eight stormy marriages a jewel encrusted lifestyle and struggles with weight and various addictions that provided the most riveting drama Long before the age of reality television Taylor showed how fame could take on a volatile life of its own obscuring the real person behind the media fa ade Now in this compelling biography we meet the real Elizabeth Taylor as she grows from precocious child star to the most beautiful woman in the world to serious actress to pop culture punch line and finally successful entrepreneur philanthropist and HIV AIDS activist Along the way she is vilified by fans for stealing singer Eddie Fischer from Debbie Reynolds becomes trapped in a cycle of destructive affairs with Richard Burton and desperately tries to recapture the childhood she never had with the eccentric pop star Michael Jackson I ve always admitted that I m ruled by my passions she once said and those passions make for a gripping epic tale of tribulation and triumph
