Data Stream Management Minos Garofalakis, Johannes Gehrke, Rajeev Rastogi, 2016-07-11 This volume focuses on the theory and practice of data stream management and the novel challenges this emerging domain poses for data management algorithms systems and applications The collection of chapters contributed by authorities in the field offers a comprehensive introduction to both the algorithmic theoretical foundations of data streams as well as the streaming systems and applications built in different domains A short introductory chapter provides a brief summary of some basic data streaming concepts and models and discusses the key elements of a generic stream query processing architecture Subsequently Part I focuses on basic streaming algorithms for some key analytics functions e g quantiles norms join aggregates heavy hitters over streaming data Part II then examines important techniques for basic stream mining tasks e g clustering classification frequent itemsets Part III discusses a number of advanced topics on stream processing algorithms and Part IV focuses on system and language aspects of data stream processing with surveys of influential system prototypes and language designs Part V then presents some representative applications of streaming techniques in different domains e g network management financial analytics Finally the volume concludes with an overview of current data streaming products and new application domains e g cloud computing big data analytics and complex event processing and a discussion of future directions in this exciting field The book provides a comprehensive overview of core concepts and technological foundations as well as various systems and applications and is of particular interest to students lecturers and researchers in the area of data stream management

Stream Data Mining: Algorithms and Their Probabilistic Properties Leszek Rutkowski, Maciej Jaworski, Piotr Duda, 2019-03-16 This book presents a unique approach to stream data mining Unlike the vast majority of previous approaches which are largely based on heuristics it highlights methods and algorithms that are mathematically justified First it describes how to adapt static decision trees to accommodate data streams in this regard new splitting criteria are developed to guarantee that they are asymptotically equivalent to the classical batch tree Moreover new decision trees are designed leading to the original concept of hybrid trees In turn nonparametric techniques based on Parzen kernels and orthogonal series are employed to address concept drift in the problem of non stationary regressions and classification in a time varying environment Lastly an extremely challenging problem that involves designing ensembles and automatically choosing their sizes is described and solved Given its scope the book is intended for a professional audience of researchers and practitioners who deal with stream data e g in telecommunication banking and sensor networks
