Monsieur. Second Sons in the Monarchy of France, 1550-1800 Jonathan Spangler, 2021-11-28 For the first time this volume brings together the history of the royal spare in the monarchy of early modern France those younger brothers of kings known simply as Monsieur Ranging from the Wars of Religion to the French Revolution this comparative study examines the frustrations of four royal princes whose proximity to their older brothers gave them vast privileges and great prestige but also placed severe limitations on their activities and aspirations Each chapter analyses a different aspect of the lives of François duke of Alençon Gaston duke of Orléans Philippe duke of Orléans and Louis Stanislas count of Provence starting with their birth and education their marriages and political careers and their search for alternative expressions of power through the patronage of the arts architecture and learning By comparing these four lives a powerful image emerges of a key development in the institution of modern monarchy the transformation of the rebellious politically ambitious prince into the loyal defender even in disagreement of the Crown and of the older brother who wore it This volume is the perfect resource for all students and scholars interested in the history of France monarchy early modern state building and court studies

French Royal Women during the Restoration and July Monarchy Heta Aali, 2021-06-10 This book examines public discussions around France's four most prominent royal women during the first and second Restoration and July Monarchy the duchesse d'Angoulême the duchesse de Berry Queen of the French Marie-Amélie and Adélaïde d'Orléans These were the most powerful women of the last decades of the French monarchy but the new roles women were assigned in post-revolutionary France did not permit them to openly exercise political influence This book explores continuities and variations in narratives of royal legitimacy and how historians

authors and politicians used national history particularly medieval and early modern history to either legitimize or undermine the French monarchy and to define women's social and political roles

The Culture of Disaster Marie-Hélène Huet, 2024-05-31 From antiquity through the Enlightenment disasters were attributed to the obscure power of the stars or the vengeance of angry gods As philosophers sought to reassess the origins of natural disasters they also made it clear that humans shared responsibility for the damages caused by a violent universe This far ranging book explores the way writers thinkers and artists have responded to the increasingly political concept of disaster from the Enlightenment until today Marie H l ne Huet argues that post Enlightenment culture has been haunted by the sense of emergency that made natural catastrophes and human deeds both a collective crisis and a personal tragedy From the plague of 1720 to the cholera of 1832 from shipwrecks to film dystopias disasters raise questions about identity and memory technology control and liability In her analysis Huet considers anew the mythical figures of Medusa and Apollo theories of epidemics earthquakes political crises and films such as *Blow Up* and *Blade Runner* With its scope and precision *The Culture of Disaster* will appeal to a wide public interested in modern culture philosophy and intellectual history

Memoirs from Beyond the Grave: 1768-1800 François-René de Chateaubriand, 2018-02-20 Written over the course of four decades François René L de Chateaubriand's epic autobiography has drawn the admiration of Baudelaire Flaubert Proust Roland Barthes Paul Auster and W G Sebald In this unabridged section of the Memoirs spanning the years 1768 to 1800 Chateaubriand looks back on the already bygone world of his youth He recounts the history of his aristocratic family and the first rumblings of the French Revolution He recalls playing games on the beaches of Saint Malo wandering in the woods near his father's castle in Combourg hunting with King Louis XVI at Versailles witnessing the first heads carried on pikes through the streets of Paris meeting with George Washington in Philadelphia and falling hopelessly in love with a young woman named Charlotte in the small Suffolk town of Bungay The volume ends with Chateaubriand's return to France after eight years of exile in England In this new edition the first unabridged translation of any portion of the Memoirs to be published in more than a century Chateaubriand emerges as a writer of great wit and clarity a self deprecating egoist whose meditations on the meaning of history memory and morality are leavened with a mixture of high whimsy and memorable gloom
