Acute Breast Swelling (ABS)

Acute breast swelling (ABS) is a common condition in the intensive care unit (ICU) and is often associated with mechanical ventilation. It is characterized by a sudden increase in breast volume, which can lead to respiratory compromise and hemodynamic instability.

Causes of ABS:

- Increased intrathoracic pressure (e.g., positive end-expiratory pressure (PEEP), mechanical ventilation)
- Fluid overload
- Cardiac failure
- Renal failure
- Systemic hypertension
- Systemic vasodilation
- Systemic inflammation
- Systemic infection
- Systemic coagulopathy
- Systemic thrombocytopenia

CHEST TUBES

Chest Tubes

Chest tubes are used to drain air, fluid, or blood from the pleural space. They are commonly used in the intensive care unit (ICU) to manage conditions such as pneumothorax, hemothorax, and pleural effusion.

Indications for Chest Tubes:

- Pneumothorax
- Hemothorax
- Pleural effusion
- Empyema
- Chylothorax
- Hydrothorax
- Chyloplegic effusion
- Hydrothorax

Contraindications for Chest Tubes:

- Coagulopathy
- Thrombocytopenia
- Systemic infection

Parameter	Normal Range	Abnormal Range
Mean Arterial Pressure (MAP)	70-100 mmHg	< 60 mmHg
Cardiac Output (CO)	4-8 L/min	< 4 L/min
Stroke Volume (SV)	70-100 mL	< 50 mL
Systemic Vascular Resistance (SVR)	1000-1500 dyne/cm ²	> 1500 dyne/cm ²
Pulmonary Vascular Resistance (PVR)	100-200 dyne/cm ²	> 200 dyne/cm ²
Right Atrial Pressure (RAP)	0-10 mmHg	> 10 mmHg
Right Ventricular Pressure (RVP)	0-10 mmHg	> 10 mmHg
Left Atrial Pressure (LAP)	0-10 mmHg	> 10 mmHg
Left Ventricular Pressure (LVP)	0-10 mmHg	> 10 mmHg
