Subjects and Aliens Kate Bagnall, Peter Prince, 2023-08-29 Subjects and Aliens confronts the problematic history of belonging in Australia and New Zealand In both countries race has often been more important than the law in determining who is considered one of us Each chapter in the collection highlights the lived experiences of people who negotiated laws and policies relating to nationality and citizenship rights in twentieth century Australasia including Chinese Australians enlisting during the First World War Dalmatian gum diggers turned farmers in New Zealand Indians in 1920s Australia arguing for their citizenship rights and Australian women who lost their nationality
