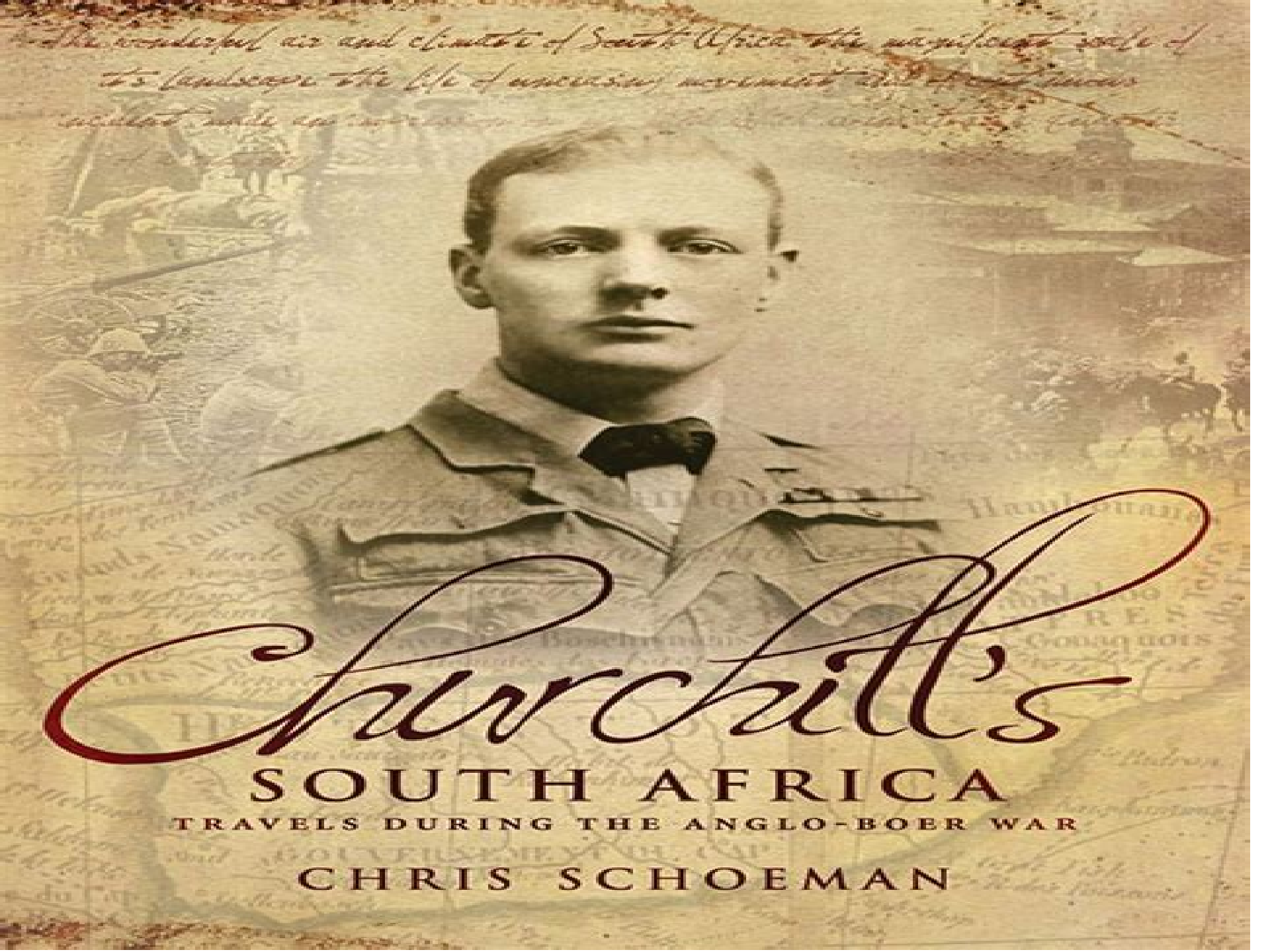

Nuns Across the Orange: A History of the Pioneering Anglican Community of St Michael and All Angels, Bloemfontein Michael Sparrow, 2021-04-21 When Sister Emma and the five women who accompanied her from England crossed the Orange River early in 1874 they exchanged the comfortable mainstream of Anglican Church life for the rigours of pioneering new works in an undeveloped country Living conditions were primitive travel was hard and money was always in short supply The newly formed Community of St Michael and All Angels opened the first girls schools north of the Orange and the first hospital in the Free State At Kimberley Sister Henrietta achieved a world first through her successful campaign for the State Registration of nurses Four Sisters were besieged in Kimberley during the Anglo Boer War and in Bloemfontein their Mother House became a military hospital By faith and determination the Community recovered St Michael's School was raised to new standards of excellence while the Sisters expanded their mission to include Lesotho and the eastern Free State Decades of work with Bloemfontein's sick and deprived led to Sister Enid becoming known as Ma Mohau Mother of Mercy and to national acclaim in the 1970s as South Africa's Mother Teresa This book studies the development of the Community's religious life and charts the progress of their work among all races from their foundation until the death of the last Sister in 2016 Across the Orange their relative isolation from the strong centres of Anglicanism eventually contributed to their demise but not before they had established an enduring legacy The work they began in Lesotho is continued by the Community of the Holy Name while St Michael's School in Bloemfontein is recognised as one of the finest girls schools in South Africa

The Unknown Van Gogh Chris Schoeman, 2015-07-01 Much has been written about Vincent van Gogh and his tempestuous relationship with his brother Theo But few people know that there was a third Van Gogh brother Cornelis who was raised in the Netherlands but worked married and died in South Africa The son of a Protestant minister Cor spent his youth in a series of small Dutch towns with idyllic holidays walking in the countryside with his artist brother before troubles and tragedies beset the Van Gogh family In 1889 the twenty two year old Cor sailed to South Africa where he worked as an engineer on the gold mines and on the railways In the Anglo Boer War he joined the Boers first as a railway engineer and later on commando in the Free State where in 1900 he suffered a fate that echoed his famous brother's tragic end *The Unknown Van Gogh* recreates South Africa in the tumultuous last decade of the nineteenth century reconstructs the personal story of a young immigrant from letters and other archival documents and explores his relationship with his famous brother Vincent With new insights based on original research this book uncovers a

Brad Faught,2023-09-30 This timely book fills a lacuna in the extensive literature on Churchill s life and times It covers his long relationship with Africa during the most important period in Anglo African history from nineteenth century imperial rule to independence and the emergence of modern Africa Churchill first went to Africa during the British re conquest of Sudan in 1898 and would spend almost the next sixty years dealing with Africa as soldier journalist government minister and finally prime minister Churchill s story is one of transition from the height of late Victorian British imperialism to the acceptance of African nationalism in the middle years of the twentieth century He helped to shape British colonial policy in Africa from the first decade of the twentieth century through the Second World War and colonial Kenya s Mau Mau crisis of the 1950s Few British leaders were as closely involved with Africa as was Churchill **The Somme Chronicles** Chris Schoeman,2014-06-05 The heavy smell of blood filled the air and every moment you had this intense fear that the next bullet was meant for you So remembered William Thorne a South African volunteer soldier who fought in the muddy trenches along the River Somme in France on Europe s Western Front A boy of nineteen at the time he was one of thousands of South Africans who took part in the 1916 Somme Offensive between the Allied forces and the Germans It was one of the bloodiest and costliest conflicts of the First World War resulting in over a million deaths The men of the 1st South African Infantry Brigade were involved on a large scale and distinguished themselves in all major engagements during the campaign But their bravery came at a price In the first month alone after six days of fighting to recapture the village of Longueval and clear Delville Wood of enemy soldiers of the brigade s 3 433 soldiers only 750 were left standing The rest

were dead or wounded By the armistice the South Africans had suffered some 15 000 casualties in France of which one third had died
