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1. *What is the difference between the two types of research?* The first type of research is *qualitative*, which means that it is based on words and descriptions. The second type is *quantitative*, which means that it is based on numbers and statistics.
2. *What are the strengths and weaknesses of each type of research?* Qualitative research is good for understanding the meaning of things and for exploring new ideas. Quantitative research is good for testing hypotheses and for making generalizations.
3. *How do you choose which type of research to use?* It depends on the research question. If you want to understand the meaning of something, qualitative research is better. If you want to test a hypothesis, quantitative research is better.
