Developmental studies in criminology focus on psychological factors that influence the onset and persistence of criminal behavior while life course studies analyze how changes in social arrangements like marriage, education, or social networks can lead to changes in offending. Though each perspective is clearly concerned with patterns of offending and problem behavior over time, the literature on each is spread across various disciplines including criminology, criminal justice, psychology, and sociology. The Oxford Handbook on Developmental and Life Course Criminology offers the first comprehensive survey of these two approaches together. Edited by three noted authorities in the field, the volume provides in-depth critical reviews of the development of offending, developmental and life course theories, development correlates, and risk/protective factors, life transitions, and turning points, and effective developmental interventions from the world's leading scholars.
