It provides new material on the difference between population trends and household trends the impact of Hispanic immigration and the potential for city county consolidation. The fourth edition also brings added emphasis to elasticity mimics a variety of intergovernmental policies that can provide some of the benefits of regional consolidation efforts in situations where annexation and consolidation are impossible
