Critical Laboratory Thomas Hirschhorn, 2013-07-19 Writings by Thomas Hirschhorn collected for the first time trace the development of the artist's ideas and artistic strategies. For the artist Thomas Hirschhorn, writing is a crucial tool at every stage of his artistic practice. From the first sketch of an idea to appeals to potential collaborators, from detailed documentation of projects to post-disassembly analysis, Hirschhorn's writings mark the trajectories of his work. This volume collects Hirschhorn's widely scattered texts, presenting many in English for the first time. In these writings, Hirschhorn discusses the full range of his art, from works on paper to the massive *Presence and Production* projects in public spaces. Statements and Letters address broad themes of aesthetic philosophy, politics, and art historical commitments. Projects consider specific artworks or exhibitions. Interviews capture the artist in dialogue with Benjamin Buchloh, Jacques Rancière, and others. Throughout, certain continuities emerge: Hirschhorn's commitment to quotidian materials, the centrality of political and economic thinking in his work, and his commitment to art in the public sphere. Taken together, the texts serve to trace the artist's ideas and artistic strategies over the past two decades. *Critical Laboratory* also reproduces in color 33 *Ausstellungen im öffentlichen Raum* 1998-1989, an out-of-print catalog of Hirschhorn's earliest works in public space. *Thomas Hirschhorn* Anna Dezeuze, 2014-08-29 An illustrated examination of one of Hirschhorn's precarious monuments now dismantled. Part text, part sculpture, part architecture, part junk heap, Thomas Hirschhorn's often monumental but precarious works offer a commentary on the spectacle of late capitalist consumerism and the global proliferation of commodities. Made from ephemeral materials—cardboard, foil, plastic bags, and packing tape—that the artist describes as universal, economic, inclusive, and without any plus value, these works also engage issues of justice, power, and moral responsibility. Hirschhorn, born in Switzerland in 1957, often chooses to place his work in non-art settings, saying that he wants it to fight for its own existence. In this book, Anna Dezeuze offers a generously illustrated examination of Hirschhorn's *Deleuze Monument* 2000, the second in his series of four *Monuments Deleuze*. *Monument*, a sculpture, an altar, and a library dedicated to Gilles Deleuze, was conceived as a work open to visitors twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week. Part of the exhibition *La Beauté* in Avignon, *Deleuze Monument* was controversial from the start and it was dismantled two months before the end of the exhibition, after being vandalized. Dezeuze describes the chronology of the project, including negotiations with local residents, the dynamic between affirmation and vulnerability in Hirschhorn's work, failure and scatter art in the 1990s, participatory practices, and problems of presence, maintenance, and appearance raised by Hirschhorn's acknowledgement of error in his discontinuous presence on site following the installation of *Deleuze Monument*. **Thomas Hirschhorn** Christina Braun, 2018-03-06 Thomas Hirschhorn, a leading installation artist whose work is owned and exhibited by modern art museums throughout Europe and the United States, is known for compelling, often site-specific and interactive environments tackling issues of critical theory, global politics, and consumerism. Almost nothing Anna Deuze, 2016-12-21 What does an assemblage made out of crumpled newspaper have in common with an empty room in which the lights go on and off every five seconds This book argues that they are both examples of a precarious art that flourished from the late 1950s to the first decade of the twenty first century in light of a growing awareness of the individual's fragile existence in capitalist society Focusing on comparative case studies drawn from European North and South American practices this study maps out a network of similar concerns and practices while outlining its evolution from the 1960s to the beginning of the twenty first century This book will provide students and amateurs of contemporary art and culture with new insights into contemporary art practices and the critical issues that they raise concerning the material status of the art object the role of the artist in society and the relation between art and everyday life

Kester examines the evolving discourse of aesthetic autonomy from its origins in the Enlightenment through avant garde projects and movements in the nineteenth and twentieth centuries Kester traces the idea of aesthetic autonomy the sense that art should be autonomous from social forces while retaining the ability to reflect back critically on society through Kant Schiller Hegel Marx and Adorno Kester critiques the use of aesthetic autonomy as the basis for understanding the nature of art and the shifting relationship between art and revolutionary praxis He shows that dominant discourses of aesthetic autonomy reproduce the very forms of bourgeois liberalism that autonomy discourse itself claims to challenge Analyzing avant garde art and political movements in Russia India Latin America and elsewhere Kester retheorizes the aesthetic beyond autonomy Ultimately Kester demonstrates that the question of aesthetic autonomy has ramifications that extend beyond art to encompass the nature of political transformation and forms of anticolonial resistance that challenge the Eurocentric concept of Man upon which the aesthetic itself often depends

Vittoria Martini Vittoria Martini, 2023-05-15 The Bijlmer Spinoza Festival is an artwork a sculpture created by Swiss artist Thomas Hirschhorn in a peripheral borough of Amsterdam's south east known as the Bijlmer in 2009 This book recounts the event through the eyes of its Ambassador art historian Vittoria Martini who was invited by the artist to be an eyewitness to the existence of this precarious work A term Hirschhorn sees as positive and creative a means of asserting the importance of the moment and of the place of asserting the Here and Now to touch eternity and universality Appreciating the art historian's presence as a central element of his sculpture Hirschhorn consciously challenged the certainties of the profession by empowering and activating the role thus leading Martini to find a new working methodology that she calls precarious art history Accompanying the readers through her experience of the physical existence of The Bijlmer Spinoza Festival Martini's commentary leads to the profound understanding of how a work that no longer exists physically can live on in the mind elsewhere at some other time because in the meantime it has become universal Paris based artist THOMAS HIRSCHHORN 1957 Bern is best known for his sculptures in public space monuments kiosks and altars Questioning the autonomy the authorship and resistance of a work of art he asserts the power of art to touch and transform the other He represented Switzerland at the 54th Venice Biennale in 2011 and received numerous awards including the Prix Marcel Duchamp and the Joseph Beuys Stiftung Prize VITTORIA MARTINI 1975 Kinshasa is an independent art historian living in Italy She has a doctorate from Università Ca Foscari Università Iuav di Venezia Since 2013 she teaches History of exhibitions and curatorial practices and holds the Art Writing workshop at CAMPO Program of curatorial studies and practices established by the Fondazione Sandretto Re Rebaudengo Turin Italy Her research focuses mainly on the institutional structures that produce exhibitions
