Ballenger, 2000 The origin of this collection of essays was a 1997 symposium held to celebrate the life legacy and work of Alois Alzheimer who described the disease in 1907 One of the first chapters of the book tells the fascinating story of how the case notes for Alzheimer's article were recently discovered in the archives of his department in Frankfurt In a book focused on the history of Alzheimer's disease we can see the evolution of our concepts of this disease It was described clinically at first and then pathologically In the 1970s and 1980s the disorder was viewed as a neurochemical entity the cholinergic hypothesis Today we consider Alzheimer's disease a genetic disorder related to chromosomes and apolipoprotein E How will we view it in the future

Kinoshita, 2006-06-26 Traces how the true importance of Alzheimer's disease AD as the major cause of late life dementia ultimately came to light and narrates the evolution of the concepts related to AD throughout the years and its recognition as a major public health problem

Living with Alzheimer's Renée L. Beard, 2016-04-26 News of Alzheimer's disease is constantly in the headlines Every day we hear heart wrenching stories of people caring for a loved one who has become a shell of their former self of projections about rising incidence rates and of cures that are just around the corner However we don't see or hear from the people who actually have the disease In *Living with Alzheimer's* Renée L. Beard argues that the exclusively negative portrayals of Alzheimer's are grossly inaccurate To understand what life with memory loss is really like Beard draws on intensive observations of nearly 100 seniors undergoing cognitive evaluation as well as post diagnosis interviews with individuals experiencing late in life forgetfulness Since we all forget sometimes seniors with an Alzheimer's diagnosis ultimately need to be socialized into medicalized interpretations of their forgetfulness In daily life people with the disease are forced to manage stigma and the presumption of incompetence on top of the actual symptoms of their ailment The well meaning public and not their dementia becomes the major barrier to a happy life for those affected Beard also examines how these perceptions affect treatment for Alzheimer's Interviews with clinicians and staff from the Alzheimer's Association reveal that despite the best of intentions pejorative framings of life with dementia fuel both clinical practice and advocacy efforts These professionals perpetuate narratives about self loss impending cures and the economic and emotional burden to families and society even if they do not personally believe them Yet Beard also concludes that in spite of these trends most of the diagnosed individuals in her study achieve a graceful balance between accepting the medical label and resisting the social stigma that accompanies it In stark contrast to the messages we receive this book provides an unprecedented view into the ways that people with early Alzheimer's actively and deliberately navigate their lives

Self, Senility, and Alzheimer's Disease in Modern America Jesse F. Ballenger, 2006-03-31 Historian Jesse F. Ballenger traces the emergence of senility as a cultural category from the late nineteenth century to the 1980s a period in which Alzheimer's disease became increasingly

associated with the terrifying prospect of losing one's self. Changes in American society and culture have complicated the notion of selfhood. Ballenger finds no longer an ascribed status; selfhood must be carefully and willfully constructed. Thus losing one's ability to sustain a coherent self narrative is considered one of life's most dreadful losses. As Ballenger writes, senility haunts the landscape of the self-made man. Stereotypes of senility and Alzheimer's disease are related to anxiety about the coherence, stability, and agency of the self—stereotypes that are transforming perceptions of old age in modern America. Drawing on scientific, clinical, policy, and popular discourses on aging and dementia, Ballenger explores early twentieth-century concepts of aging and the emergence of gerontology to understand and distinguish normal aging from disease. In addition, he examines American psychiatry's approaches to the treatment of senility and scientific attempts to understand the brain pathology of dementia. Ballenger's work contributes to our understanding of the emergence and significance of dementia as a major health issue.

Dementia Reimagined Tia Powell, 2020-09-01. Now in paperback, the cultural and medical history of dementia and Alzheimer's disease by a leading psychiatrist and bioethicist who urges us to turn our focus from cure to care. Despite being a physician and a bioethicist, Tia Powell wasn't prepared to address the challenges she faced when her grandmother and then her mother were diagnosed with dementia, not to mention confronting the hard truth that her own odds aren't great. In the U.S., 10,000 baby boomers turn 65 every day; by the time a person reaches 85, their chances of having dementia approach 50 percent. And the truth is, there is no cure, and none coming soon, despite the perpetual promises by pharmaceutical companies that they are just one more expensive study away from a pill. Dr. Powell's goal is to move the conversation away from an exclusive focus on cure to a genuine appreciation of care: what we can do for those who have dementia and how to keep life meaningful and even joyful. *Reimagining Dementia* is a moving combination of medicine and memoir, peeling back the untold history of dementia from the story of Solomon Fuller, a Black doctor whose research at the turn of the twentieth century anticipated important aspects of what we know about dementia today, to what has been gained and lost with the recent bonanza of funding for Alzheimer's at the expense of other forms of the disease. In demystifying dementia, Dr. Powell helps us understand it with clearer eyes from the point of view of both physician and caregiver. Ultimately, she wants us all to know that dementia is not only about loss; it's also about the preservation of dignity and hope.

The Alzheimer Conundrum Margaret Lock, 2015-10-20. Why our approaches to Alzheimer's and dementia are problematic and contradictory. Due to rapidly aging populations, the number of people worldwide experiencing dementia is increasing, and the projections are grim. Despite billions of dollars invested in medical research, no effective treatment has been discovered for Alzheimer's disease, the most common form of dementia. *The Alzheimer Conundrum* exposes the predicaments embedded in current efforts to slow down or halt Alzheimer's disease through early detection of pre-symptomatic biological changes in healthy individuals.
