Critical Writings F. T. Marinetti, 2006-10-03 The Futurist movement was founded and promoted by Filippo Tommaso Marinetti beginning in 1909 with the First Futurist Manifesto in which he inveighed against the complacency of cultural necrophiliacs and sought to annihilate the values of the past writing that there is no longer any beauty except the struggle Any work of art that lacks a sense of aggression can never be a masterpiece In the years that followed up until his death in 1944 Marinetti through both his polemical writings and his political activities sought to transform society in all its aspects As G nter Berghaus writes in his introduction Futurism sought to bridge the gap between art and life and to bring aesthetic innovation into the real world Life was to be changed through art and art was to become a form of life This volume includes more than seventy of Marinetti s most important writings many of them translated into English for the first time offering the reader a representative and still startling selection of texts concerned with Futurist art literature politics and philosophy

The Collected Works of Theodore Parker: Critical writings Theodore Parker, 1864 *Collected Critical Writings* Geoffrey Hill, 2009 The Collected Critical Writings gathers more than forty years of Hill s published criticism in a revised final form and also adds much new work It will serve as the canonical volume of criticism by Hill the pre eminent poet critic whom A N Wilson has called probably the best writer alive in verse or in prose In his criticism Hill ranges widely investigating both poets including Jonson Dryden Hopkins Whitman Eliot and Yeats and prose writers such as Tyndale Clarendon Hobbes Burton Emerson and F H Bradley He is also steeped in the historical context political poetic and religious of the writers he studies Most importantly he brings texts and contexts into new and telling relations neither reducing texts to the circumstances of their utterance nor imagining that they can float free of them A number of the essays have already established themselves as essential reading on particular subjects such as his analysis of Vaughan s *The Night* his discussion of Gurney s poetry and his critical account of *The Oxford English Dictionary* Others confront the problems of language and the nature of value directly as in *Our Word is Our Bond* *Language Suffering and Value* and *Poetry and Value* In all his criticism Hill reveals literature to be an essential arena of civic intelligence

McCay crafted narratives of anticipation, abundance, and unfulfilled longing. This book explores McCay's interest in dream imagery in relation to the larger preoccupation with fantasy that dominated the popular culture of early twentieth-century urban America. McCay's role as a pioneer of early comics has been documented, yet no existing study approaches him and his work from an art historical perspective, giving close readings of individual artworks while situating his output within the larger visual culture and the rise of modernism. From circus posters and vaudeville skits to department store window displays and amusement park rides, McCay found fantastical inspiration in New York City's burgeoning entertainment and retail districts. *Wide Awake in Slumberland* connects McCay's work to relevant children's literature, advertising, architecture, and motion pictures in order to demonstrate the artist's sophisticated blending and remixing of multiple forms from mass culture. Studying this interconnection in McCay's work and, by extension, the work of other early twentieth-century cartoonists, Roeder traces the web of relationships connecting fantasy, leisure, and consumption. Readings of McCay's drawings and the eighty-one black and white and color illustrations reveal a man who was both a ready participant and an incisive critic of the rising culture of fantasy and consumerism. Muse argues that plays shorter than twenty minutes deserve sustained attention and that brevity should be considered a distinct mode of theatrical practice. Focusing on artists for whom brevity became both a structural principle and a tool to investigate theater itself, August Strindberg, Maurice Maeterlinck, F. T. Marinetti, Samuel Beckett, Suzan-Lori Parks, and Caryl Churchill, the book explores four episodes in the history of very short theater, all characterized by the self-conscious embrace of brevity.
