Concluding Unscientific Postscript to Philosophical Fragments Søren Kierkegaard, 2013-04-21 In *Philosophical Fragments* the pseudonymous author Johannes Climacus explored the question What is required in order to go beyond Socratic recollection of eternal ideas already possessed by the learner Written as an afterword to this work *Concluding Unscientific Postscript* is on one level a philosophical jest yet on another it is Climacus's characterization of the subjective thinker's relation to the truth of Christianity At once ironic humorous and polemical this work takes on the unscientific form of a mimical pathetical dialectical compilation of ideas Whereas the movement in the earlier pseudonymous writings is away from the aesthetic the movement in *Postscript* is away from speculative thought Kierkegaard intended *Postscript* to be his concluding work as an author The subsequent second authorship after *The Corsair Affair* made *Postscript* the turning point in the entire authorship Part One of the text volume examines the truth of Christianity as an objective issue Part Two the subjective issue of what is involved for the individual in becoming a Christian and the volume ends with an addendum in which Kierkegaard acknowledges and explains his relation to the pseudonymous authors and their writings The second volume contains the scholarly apparatus including a key to references and selected entries from Kierkegaard's journals and papers

Kierkegaard Bibliography Peter Šajda, Jon Bartley Stewart, 2016 Kierkegaard Bibliography Peter Šajda; Jon Stewart, 2016 Kierkegaard's Journals and Notebooks, Volume 6 Søren Kierkegaard, 2013-01-06 For over a century the Danish thinker Søren Kierkegaard 1813-55 has been at the center of a number of important discussions concerning not only philosophy and theology but also more recently fields such as social thought psychology and contemporary aesthetics especially literary theory Despite his relatively short life Kierkegaard was an extraordinarily prolific writer as attested to by the 26 volume Princeton University Press edition of all of his published writings But Kierkegaard left behind nearly as much unpublished writing most of which consists of what are called his journals and notebooks Kierkegaard has long been recognized as one of history's great journal keepers but only rather small portions of his journals and notebooks are what we usually understand by the term diaries By far the greater part of Kierkegaard's journals and notebooks consists of reflections on a myriad of subjects philosophical religious political personal Studying his journals and notebooks takes us into his workshop where we can see his entire universe of thought We can witness the genesis of his published works to be sure but we can also see whole galaxies of concepts new insights and fragments large and small of partially or almost entirely completed but unpublished works Kierkegaard's *Journals and Notebooks* enables us to see the thinker in dialogue with his times and with himself Volume 6 of this 11 volume series includes four of Kierkegaard's important NB journals Journals NB11 through NB14 covering the months from early May 1849 to the beginning of 1850 At this time Denmark was coming to terms with the 1848 revolution that had replaced absolutism with popular sovereignty while the war with the German states continued and the country pondered exactly what replacing the old State Church with the Danish People's Church would

mean In these journals Kierkegaard reflects at length on political and especially on ecclesiastical developments His brooding over the ongoing effects of his fight with the satirical journal *Corsair* continues and he also examines and re examines the broader personal and religious significance of his broken engagement with Regine Olsen These journals also contain reflections by Kierkegaard on a number of his most important works including the two works written under his new pseudonym Anti Climacus *The Sickness unto Death* and *Practice in Christianity* and his various attempts at autobiographical explanations of his work And all the while the drumbeat of his radical critique of Christendom continues and escalates Kierkegaard wrote his journals in a two column format one for his initial entries and the second for the extensive marginal comments that he added later This edition of the journals reproduces this format includes several photographs of original manuscript pages and contains extensive scholarly commentary on the various entries and on the history of the manuscripts being reproduced *Concluding Unscientific Postscript to Philosophical Fragments* Søren Kierkegaard, 1992

Kierkegaard and His Danish Contemporaries: Philosophy, politics and social theory Jon Bartley Stewart, 2009

The present volume features articles that employ source work research in order to explore the individual Danish sources of Kierkegaard's thought The volume is divided into three tomes in order to cover the different fields of influence Tome I is dedicated to exploring the sources that fall under the rubrics Philosophy Politics and Social Theory With regard to philosophy Kierkegaard read the works of all the foremost Danish thinkers of the time and their German antecedents in particular Kant Schelling and Hegel While he was sympathetic to individual ideas offered by this tradition he was generally keen to criticise the German model of philosophy and to propose a new paradigm for philosophical thought that was more in tune with lived existence Kierkegaard also experienced the dynamic period in history that saw the great upheavals throughout Europe in connection with the revolutions of 1848 and the First Schleswig War While it has long been claimed that Kierkegaard was not interested in politics recent research supports a quite different picture To be sure he cannot be regarded as a political scientist or social theorist in a traditional sense but he was nonetheless engaged in the issues of his day and in his works one can certainly find material that can be insightful for the fields of politics and social theory **Volume 8, Tome II:**

Kierkegaard's International Reception - Southern, Central and Eastern Europe Jon Stewart, 2016-12-14 Although Kierkegaard's reception was initially more or less limited to Scandinavia it has for a long time now been a highly international affair As his writings were translated into different languages his reputation spread and he became read more and more by people increasingly distant from his native Denmark While in Scandinavia the attack on the Church in the last years of his life became something of a cause célèbre later many different aspects of his work became the object of serious scholarly investigation well beyond the original northern borders As his reputation grew he was co-opted by a number of different philosophical and religious movements in different contexts throughout the world The three tomes of this volume attempt to record the history of this reception according to national and linguistic categories Tome II covers the reception of

Kierkegaard in Southern Central and Eastern Europe The first set of articles under the rubric Southern Europe covers Portugal Spain and Italy A number of common features were shared in these countries reception of Kierkegaard including a Catholic cultural context and a debt to the French reception The next rubric covers the rather heterogeneous group of countries designated here as Central Europe Hungary the Czech Republic Slovakia and Poland These countries are loosely bound in a cultural sense by their former affiliation with the Habsburg Empire and in a religious sense by their shared Catholicism Finally the Orthodox countries of Eastern Europe are represented with articles on Russia Bulgaria Serbia and Montenegro Macedonia and Romania

Where the Truth Lies Shane R. Cudney, 2021-11-23 Johannes de Silentio the pseudonymous author of *Fear and Trembling* concludes that faith is absurd irrational and therefore lies beyond the scope of reason But if we ascribe authorship ultimately to Kierkegaard as is common practice we must conclude that he himself is an irrationalist Given the myriad of competing voices throughout Kierkegaard's writings this seems highly questionable at best If however we take the pseudonymous author strictly at his authorial word it changes the shape and dynamic of the text inviting us to read it instead as a thought experiment In this way the text demonstrates both the absurdity and sin of reason in its bid to fully grasp the mystery of faith on its own rational terms

The Joy of Kierkegaard Hugh S. Pyper, 2014-10-20 Kierkegaard has often been regarded as a gloomy thinker yet as an evangelist his aim was to discover the joy of the truth of Christianity Both Kierkegaard's belief and his doubt in his own work were the result of his attempt to comprehend the exceptional experiences of biblical characters and to examine what he found most puzzling or offensive The Joy of Kierkegaard brings together the writings of one of the most influential of Kierkegaard scholars These essays argue that Kierkegaard's most original thought arises from his struggle with biblical passages and that joy underpins his profound exploration of spiritual alienation
