The Face of Things Silvia Benso, 2000-06-01 Engages Levinas and Heidegger on the provocative issue of an ethics of things *Heidegger's Ontological Project* John Sallis, 2024-10-22 This long awaited volume of The Collected Writings of John Sallis presents his lectures on Martin Heidegger's monumental Being and Time. The lectures were presented during the 1985-86 academic year at Loyola University of Chicago and during the fall semester of 1999 at Pennsylvania State University. The fourteen years separating the beginning of the two courses is significant in that many of the Gesamtausgabe volumes appeared in that interval as well as a second translation of Being and Time. While the additional Gesamtausgabe volumes make no appearance in the Sallis lectures, there is certainly an awareness of them. This book is a synthesis of the manuscripts of the two separate lecture courses. This volume makes Being and Time accessible to students, while the most advanced scholars will also profit from it.

Husserl's Crisis of the European Sciences and Transcendental Phenomenology Dermot Moran, 2012-08-23 The Crisis of the European Sciences is Husserl's last and most influential book, written in Nazi Germany where he was discriminated against as a Jew. It incisively identifies the urgent moral and existential crises of the age and defends the relevance of philosophy at a time of both scientific progress and political barbarism. It is also a response to Heidegger, offering Husserl's own approach to the problems of human finitude, history, and culture. The Crisis introduces Husserl's influential notion of the life-world, the pre-given familiar environment that includes both nature and culture, and offers the best introduction to his phenomenology as both method and philosophy. Dermot Moran's rich and accessible introduction to the Crisis explains its intellectual and political context, its philosophical motivations, and the themes that characterize it. His book will be invaluable for students and scholars of Husserl's work and of phenomenology in general.

The Latent World of Architecture Dalibor Vesely, 2022-09-30 This book features thirteen essays by the late architect, philosopher, and teacher Dalibor Vesely (1934-2015). Vesely was a leading authority on philosophical hermeneutics and phenomenology in relation to architecture worldwide and influenced a generation of thinkers, teachers, and practitioners. Jean-Luc Nancy and the Thinking of Otherness Daniele Rugo, 2013-05-09 Jean-Luc Nancy and the Thinking of Otherness is the first book in English to provide a sustained account of the relationship between Nancy, Levinas, and Heidegger. It investigates Jean-Luc Nancy's reading of Heidegger, focusing on the question of Being-with and starting with the

problem of otherness in Heidegger the book goes on to establish a dialogue between Nancy and the philosophy of Emmanuel Levinas With intellectual agility and command of cinema literature and visual art Daniele Rugo insists on the critical significance of Nancy s project for any future philosophy attempting to define itself beyond foundational acts and according to the continuous crossings at the heart of existence By discussing Nancy alongside Heidegger and Levinas Rugo underlines the essential indecision between philosophy as literature and philosophy as the re appropriation of the question of Being Rugo offers unexpected associations which return thinking to the play of specificity rather than restricting it to the passage of abstract formulations

The Concept of World from Kant to Derrida Sean Gaston,2013-09-20 In the mid eighteenth century metaphysics was broadly understood as the study of three areas of philosophical thought theology psychology and cosmology This book examines the fortunes of the third of these formidable metaphysical concepts the world Sean Gaston provides a clear and concise account of the concept of world from the mid eighteenth century to the end of the twentieth century exploring its possibilities and limitations and engaging with current issues in politics and ecology He focuses on the work of five principal thinkers Kant Hegel Husserl Heidegger and Derrida all of whom attempt to establish new grounds for seeing the world as a whole Gaston presents a critique of the self evident use of the concept of world in philosophy and asks whether one can move beyond the need for a world like vantage point to maintain a concept of world From Kant to the present day this concept has been a problem for philosophy and it remains to be seen if we need a new Copernican revolution when it comes to the concept of world

Heidegger's Metahistory of Philosophy: Amor Fati, Being and Truth Bernd Magnus,2014-11-14 Martin Heidegger s fame and influence are based for the most part on his first work Being and Time That this was to have been the first half of a larger two volume project the second half of which was never completed is well known That Heidegger s subsequent writings have been continuous developments of that project in some sense is generally acknowledged although there is considerable disagreement concerning the manner in which his later works stand related to Being and Time Heidegger scholars are deeply divided over that question Some maintain that there is a sharp thematic cleavage in Heidegger s thought so that the later works either refute or at best abandon the earlier themes Others maintain that even to speak of a shift or a reversal in Heidegger s thinking is mistaken and argue in consequence that his thinking develops entirely consistently Lastly there are those who admit a shift in emphasis and themes in his works but introduce a principle of complementarity the shift is said to represent a logical development of his thinking Too often the groups resemble armed camps

The Wisdom of the World Rémi Brague,2020-09-12 When the ancient Greeks looked up into the heavens they saw not just sun and moon stars and planets but a complete coherent universe a model of the Good that could serve as a guide to a better life How this view of the world came to be and how we lost it or turned away from it on the way to becoming modern make for a fascinating story told in a highly accessible manner by R mi Brague in this wide ranging cultural history Before the Greeks people thought human action was required to maintain the order of the universe and so

conducted rituals and sacrifices to renew and restore it But beginning with the Hellenic Age the universe came to be seen as existing quite apart from human action and possessing therefore a kind of wisdom that humanity did not Wearing his remarkable erudition lightly Brague traces the many ways this universal wisdom has been interpreted over the centuries from the time of ancient Egypt to the modern era Socratic and Muslim philosophers Christian theologians and Jewish Kabbalists all believed that questions about the workings of the world and the meaning of life were closely intertwined and that an understanding of cosmology was crucial to making sense of human ethics Exploring the fate of this concept in the modern day Brague shows how modernity stripped the universe of its sacred and philosophical wisdom transforming it into an ethically indifferent entity that no longer serves as a model for human morality Encyclopedic and yet intimate *The Wisdom of the World* offers the best sort of history broad learned and completely compelling Brague opens a window onto systems of thought radically different from our own
