Penal Policy Frieder Dünkel, Stefan Harrendorf, Dirk van Zyl Smit, 2022-04-19 The Impact of COVID 19 on Prison Conditions and Penal Policy presents the results of a worldwide exchange of information on the impact of COVID 19 in prisons It also focuses on the human rights questions that have been raised during the pandemic relating to the treatment of prisoners in institutions for both juveniles and adults worldwide The first part brings together the findings and conclusions of leading prison academics and practitioners presenting national reports with information on the prison system prison population rates how COVID 19 was and is managed in prisons and its impact on living conditions inside prisons and on reintegration programmes Forty four countries are covered many in Europe but also Argentina Brazil Chile Colombia Per Costa Rica Canada the USA Kenya South Africa China India Japan Australia and New Zealand In the second part thematic chapters concentrate explicitly on the impact of the pandemic on the application of international human rights standards in prisons and on worldwide prison population rates The book concludes by drawing out the commonalities and diverging practices between jurisdictions discussing the impact of measures introduced and reflecting on what could be learnt from policies that emerged during the pandemic Particular attention is paid to whether reductionist strategies that emerged during the pandemic can be used to counteract mass incarceration and prison overcrowding in the future Although the book reflects the situation until mid 2021 after the second and during the third wave of the pandemic it is highly relevant to the current situation as the living conditions in prisons did not change significantly during the following waves which showed high infection rates in particular in the general population but increased vaccination rates too In prisons problems the pandemic raises have an even greater impact than for the general society Revealing many notable and interesting changes in prison life and in release programmes this book is essential reading for students and scholars of penology criminology law sociology and public health It will also appeal to criminal justice practitioners and policy makers *Imaginary Boundaries of Justice* Ronnie Lippens, 2005-01-14 It has become increasingly difficult to speak or even think social or legal justice in an age when words have left their moorings Perhaps images are more stable than words maybe images and imagery possess a certain viscosity even a sensory quality which prevents them from evaporating This maybe is what this book is about The contributors to this collection explore the issue of how the Imaginary images imagery imagination has a role in the production and reproduction of visions of legal and social justice It argues that visions of justice are inevitably bounded Boundaries of visions of justice however are also imaginary They emerge within imaginary spaces and as they are imaginary they are inherently unstable The book captures an emerging interest in the humanities and social sciences in images and the visual or the Imaginary more broadly This collection will appeal to scholars and students of social and legal theory visual culture justice and governance studies media studies and criminology **Travels of the Criminal Question** Dario Melossi, Máximo Sozzo, Richard Sparks, 2011-02-03 The expression the criminal question does not at present have much currency in English language criminology The term was carried across from Italian debates about the orientation of

criminology and in particular debates about what came to be called critical criminology. One definition offered early in the debate described it as an area constituted by actions, institutions, policies and discourses whose boundaries shift. According to this writer, crime and the cultural and symbolic significance carried by law and criminal justice is an integral aspect of the criminal question. The criminal question draws attention to the specific location and constitution of a given field of forces and the themes, issues, dilemmas and debates that compose it. At the same time, it enables connections to be made between these embedded realities and the wider, conceivably global, contours of influence and flows of power with which it connects. This in turn raises many questions: How far do the responses to crime and punishment internationally flow from and owe their contemporary shape to the cultural and economic transformations now widely known as globalisation? How can something that is in significant ways embedded, situated and locally produced also travel? What is not in doubt is that it does travel and travel with serious consequences. The international circulation of discourses and practices has become a pressing issue for scholars who try to understand their operation in their own particular cultural contexts. This collection of essays seeks a constructive comparative view of these tendencies to convergence and divergence.

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
