Noyola, 2007-01-19 No state has a greater density of Chicano community leaders and politicians than does Texas This study examines the lives and politics of a distinguished group of Chicana women who have risen to positions of power The authors profile women who serve in various public capacities federal judges candidates for Lieutenant Governor a statewide chair of a political party and members of school boards and city and county governments The diverse careers of these women offer rare glimpses of the kinds of struggles they face both as women and as members of the Chicano community *Chicanas in Charge* will be of great value to those interested in gender studies political science local government public policy oral history biography and Chicano studies

Texas Women Elizabeth Hayes Turner, Stephanie Cole, Rebecca Sharpless, 2015 This is a collection of biographies and composite essays of Texas women contextualized over the course of history to include subjects that reflect the enormous racial class and religious diversity of the state Offering insights into the complex ways that Texas position on the margins of the United States has shaped a particular kind of gendered experience there the volume also demonstrates how the larger questions in United States women s history are answered or reconceived in the state Beginning with Juliana Barr s essay which asserts that women marked the lines of dominion among Spanish and Indian nations in Texas and explodes the myth of Spanish domination in colonial Texas the essays examine the ways that women were able to use their borderland status to stretch the boundaries of their own lives Eric Walther demonstrates that the constant changing of governments in Texas Spanish Mexican Texan and U S gave slaves the opportunities to resist their oppression because of the differences in the laws of slavery under Spanish or English or American law Gabriela Gonzalez examines the activism of Jovita Idar on behalf of civil rights for Mexicans and Mexican Americans on both sides of the border Renee Laegreid argues that female rodeo contestants employed a unique regional interplay of masculine and feminine behaviors to shape their identities as cowgirls

Chicana Power! Maylei Blackwell, 2016-06-27 The first book length study of women s involvement in the Chicano Movement of the late 1960s and 1970s *Chicana Power* tells the powerful story of the emergence of Chicana feminism within student and community based organizations throughout southern California and the Southwest As Chicanos engaged in widespread protest in their struggle for social justice civil rights and self determination women in el movimiento became increasingly militant about the gap between the rhetoric of equality and the organizational culture that suppressed women s leadership and subjected women to chauvinism discrimination and sexual harassment Based on rich oral histories and extensive archival research Maylei Blackwell analyzes the struggles over gender and sexuality within the Chicano Movement and illustrates how those struggles produced new forms of racial consciousness gender awareness and political identities *Chicana Power* provides a critical genealogy of pioneering Chicana activist and theorist Anna Nieto Gomez and the Hijas de Cuauhtemoc one of the first Latina feminist organizations who together with other Chicana activists forged an autonomous

space for women's political participation and challenged the gendered confines of Chicano nationalism in the movement and in the formation of the field of Chicana studies. She uncovers the multifaceted vision of liberation that continues to reverberate today as contemporary activists, artists, and intellectuals both grassroots and academic struggle to revise and rework the political legacy of Chicana feminism.

Suffrage at 100 Stacie Taranto, Leandra Zarnow, 2020-08-04 **Suffrage at 100** looks at women's engagement in US electoral politics and government over the one hundred years since the ratification of the Nineteenth Amendment. In the 2018 midterm elections, 102 women were elected to the House and 14 to the Senate, a record for both bodies. And yet, nearly a century after the ratification of the Nineteenth Amendment, the notion of congressional gender parity by 2020, a stated goal of the National Women's Political Caucus at the time of its founding in 1971, remains a distant ideal. In **Suffrage at 100**, Stacie Taranto and Leandra Zarnow bring together twenty-two scholars to take stock of women's engagement in electoral politics over the past one hundred years. This is the first wide-ranging collection to historically examine women's full political engagement in and beyond electoral office since they gained a constitutional right to vote. The book explores why women's access to and influence on political power remains frustratingly uneven, particularly for women of color and queer women. Examining how women have acted collectively and individually both within and outside of electoral and governmental channels, the book moves from the front lines of community organizing to the highest glass ceiling. Essays touch on labor and civil rights, education, environmentalism, enfranchisement, and voter suppression, conservatism vs. liberalism, indigeneity and transnationalism, LGBTQ and personal politics, Pan-Asian, Chicana, and Black feminisms, commemoration, and public history, and much more. Warriors for Social Justice and Equality Linda J. Quintanilla, 2025-03-17 **Warriors for Social Justice** examines the contributions of Mexican American activists to the nation's democratic values by concentrating on the activism of Maria Jimenez, 1950-2020, in Houston, Texas. Linda J. Quintanilla tells the life story of this admired immigrant and human rights activist who not only fought racist discriminations such as segregation but also typified other Mexican American activists. Quintanilla documents how Jimenez and other activists advanced social justice by promoting our nation's best virtues, especially equality. In 1971, when only 20, Jimenez already had a definition of what it meant for her to be an activist: when I see a problem which I feel needs a solution, then I go out to solve it. Quintanilla describes her lifelong battle against injustice, be it racist, sexist, or anti-immigrant animus. The Immigrant Workers Freedom Ride in 2003, only one of her many impressive achievements, delighted her the most. The experience introduced its participants, undocumented immigrants, to historic places and African American activists and descendants from the Civil Rights Movement. The Freedom Ride, Jimenez believed, not only was educational but also inspired

the immigrants in their long and difficult fight to gain legal status a true victory for social justice Quintanilla uses Critical Race Theory CRT which examines the relationship between race racism and power as the framework for studying Jim nez and Mexican American activism She describes the racial discrimination that the Mexican origin community experienced in Texas with a focus on Houston dating from the state s earliest years and continuing into the twenty first century The commonplace belief in the inferiority of the Mexican origin minority contributed for example to segregation substandard public schools and denial of the vote and jury duty Quintanilla also addresses the violence this community suffered from authorities and examines immigration laws in depth in order to provide a historical context to the current national debate on immigration

Women in Texas History Angela Boswell, 2018-10-12 Winner 2019 Liz Carpenter Award sponsored by the Texas State Historical Association TSHA In recent decades a small but growing number of historians have dedicated their tireless attention to analyzing the role of women in Texas history Each contribution and there have been many represents a brick in the wall of new Texas history From early Native societies to astronauts Women in Texas History assembles those bricks into a carefully crafted structure as the first book to cover the full scope of Texas women s history By emphasizing the differences between race and ethnicity Angela Boswell uses three broad themes to tie together the narrative of women in Texas history First the physical and geographic challenges of Texas as a place significantly affected women s lives from the struggles of isolated frontier farming to the opportunities and problems of increased urbanization Second the changing landscape of legal and political power continued to shape women s lives and opportunities from the ballot box to the courthouse and beyond Finally Boswell demonstrates the powerful influence of social and cultural forces on the identity agency and everyday life of women in Texas In challenging male dominated legal and political systems Texan women shaped and were shaped by class religion community organizations literary and artistic endeavors and more Women in Texas History is the first book to narrate the entire span of Texas women s history and marks a major achievement in telling the full story of the Lone Star State Historians and general readers alike will find this book an informative and enjoyable read for anyone interested in the history of Texas or the history of women

Quixote's Soldiers David Montejano, 2010-06-23 Detail s the grassroots interplay among the variety of ideologies individuals and organizations that made up the Chicano movement in San Antonio Texas Journal of American History In the mid 1960s San Antonio Texas was a segregated city governed by an entrenched Anglo social and business elite The Mexican American barrios of the west and south sides were characterized by substandard housing and experienced seasonal flooding Gang warfare broke out regularly Then the striking farmworkers of South Texas marched through the city and set off a social movement that transformed the barrios and ultimately brought down the old Anglo oligarchy In Quixote s Soldiers David Montejano uses a wealth of previously untapped sources including the congressional papers of Henry B Gonzalez to present an intriguing and highly readable account of this turbulent period Montejano divides the narrative into three parts In the first part he recounts how college student activists and politicized

social workers mobilized barrio youth and mounted an aggressive challenge to both Anglo and Mexican American political elites In the second part Montejano looks at the dynamic evolution of the Chicano movement and the emergence of clear gender and class distinctions as women and ex gang youth struggled to gain recognition as serious political actors In the final part Montejano analyzes the failures and successes of movement politics He describes the work of second generation movement organizations that made possible a new and more representative political order symbolized by the election of Mayor Henry Cisneros in 1981 A most welcome addition to the growing literature on the Chicana o movement of the 1960s and 1970s *Pacific Historical Review* *Albert A. Peña Jr.* José Angel Gutiérrez,2017-07-01 The political and social impact that Albert A Peña Jr had on the lives of Mexican Americans and later Chicanos is by all counts immeasurable However in part because Chicano biography has traditionally been a neglected research area among academics generally and Chicano Studies scholars specifically his life s work has not featured prominently in any biographical work to date making this volume the first of its kind It provides a richly detailed documentation of Peña s life and career from blue collar worker to judge and essay writer spanning nearly ninety years Readers will find that at the heart of his story is a focus on grassroots organizing and politics sharing leadership and a commitment to social justice **Agent of Change** Cynthia E.
