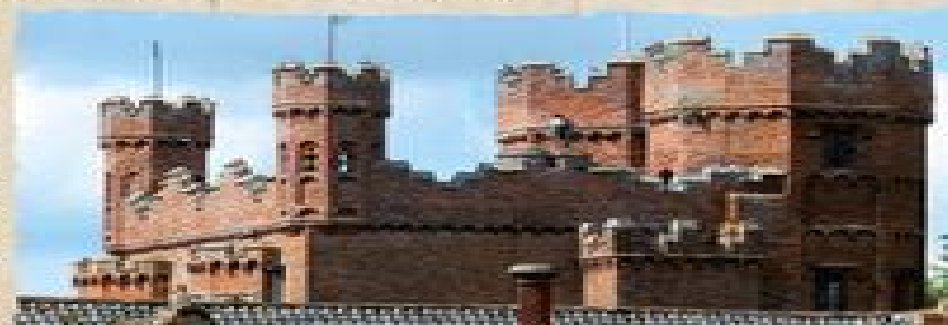

Osborne, 2013-10-01 Throughout history Cambridgeshire including Huntingdon and Peterborough has figured in many of the conflicts which have shaped our nation Doomed Roman legionaries marched from Longthorpe to defeat by Boudicca's Iceni Saxons and Danes fought over the edges of the Danelaw the Normans came this way to crush Hereward's Fenland resistance in the Civil War it provided the defended frontier between Parliamentary and Royalist in Napoleonic times French prisoners of war were incarcerated here and in the twentieth century its flat expanses were home to numerous airfields and missile bases This book describes the function and purpose of these defensive structures and reveals the evidence which many of these major events left on the ground the earthworks of hill forts medieval castles and moats the masonry of later forts and strong houses drill halls and militia barracks and the lines of anti invasion defences from 1940

Defending Nottinghamshire Mike Osborne, 2014-04-07 This book examines the impact of military events on Nottinghamshire's landscape from prehistoric hill forts to Cold War bunkers Straddling the valley of the Trent Nottinghamshire has long enjoyed a strategic importance as a frontier region in the early days of the Roman conquest and during the struggles between the emerging Saxon kingdoms and the Danes The Normans built castles to pacify the land as did the kings and barons involved in the dynastic struggles which characterised long periods of medieval times Throughout the Civil War it provided a battleground for Parliamentary forces seeking to sever the Royalist communications centred on Newark upon Trent In the twentieth century it provided training camps for Kitchener's New Armies munitions factories and both training and operational airfields This book describes the evidence function and purpose of defensive structures and records survivals

beyond *Defending Bedfordshire* Mike Osborne,2021-07-11 Over the centuries proximity to major routes the Great North Road the Icknield Way and Watling Street has made Bedfordshire strategically important Iron Age hillforts occupied significant locations and castles consolidated Norman control after 1066 In later medieval times two major events occurred in 1224 the siege of Bedford Castle marked Henry III s attempt to reimpose royal authority after the chaos of John s reign and the Second Battle of St Albans in 1461 was a major defeat for the Yorkists During the wars of the twentieth century the county s industrial base supported the armies fighting overseas In the First World War the county contributed significantly to the birth of the RAF as well as provided the base for the Home Defence armies In the Second World War its airfields despatched RAF and USAAF bombers over the continent but the major activity was the secret war largely associated with the Bedford Triangle After 1945 aeronautical research continued at RAF Thurleigh Twinwood Farm and electronic intelligence gathering was developed at Chicksands x27Defending Bedfordshire x27 seeks to explain the significance of this dense concentration of military sites to be found in a relatively small county

Defending Essex Mike Osborne,2013-02-01 For 2 000 years Essex the county with the longest coast line in England and dominating the eastern approaches to London has been in the front line against foreign invasion from the Romans to the Spanish Armada to the two World Wars It has also been involved in civil disorder from the Anarchy and the Peasants Revolt to the English Civil War Many reminders of these scenes of conflict may be seen in the landscape Iron Age forts a Roman walled town medieval castles strong houses and homestead moats coastal fortifications from Napoleonic times and earlier and Victorian barracks and the drill halls of the Volunteers From the twentieth century there are still more sites military airfields from the First World War and Battle of Britain fighter airfields radar sites and later bomber bases from the Second Anti invasion defenses line the coast linear defenses criss cross the landscape and AA sites are everywhere to be found Taking the story all the way up to the nuclear threat of the Cold War this guide will interest residents and visitors alike

Excavations at Beddington have uncovered a long occupation sequence which includes Late Bronze Age or Early Iron Age fields a Late Iron Age enclosed settlement and early Roman finds A villa was established at the site in the late 2nd century AD and included a house bathhouse and five other buildings two of which were barns although there was no direct evidence of crop or livestock production In the late 3rd century AD wings were added to the house the bathhouse was modified and the barns were replaced by a large aisled structure Unlike many other villa sites there is no evidence for continued occupation in the post Roman to early Saxon period **Religion in Britain from the Megaliths to Arthur** Robin Melrose,2016-03-11
