Reed, 2012 *The Papers of Frederick Law Olmsted* Frederick Law Olmsted, 1977 The concluding volume of the monumental Papers of Frederick Law Olmsted captures some of Olmsted's greatest achievements Choice 2015 Outstanding Academic Title In 1890 Frederick Law Olmsted then nearly sixty-eight years old had risen to the pinnacle of his career Together with his partners stepson John Charles Olmsted and protégé Henry Sargent Codman he was involved in a number of major ongoing projects including the Boston Buffalo and Rochester park systems the campus plan for Stanford University and numerous private estates In July he reported that the firm had twenty works of considerable importance underway including nine large parks and six estates that he believed were matters of public interest Before the summer ended the firm's commitments would expand dramatically as Olmsted and his partners were appointed landscape architects for the World's Columbian Exposition in Chicago As commissions for new park systems residential communities grounds for educational institutions and private homes increased Olmsted feared that their commitments would exceed the partners' ability to do their best work Despite these fears Olmsted's work in the final six years of his professional career would only enhance his considerable reputation as the ninth and final volume of *The Papers of Frederick Law Olmsted* reveals With its impressive waterways monumental buildings and verdant islands and shores the Chicago fair proved to be one of the firm's crowning achievements The early 1890s also saw the culmination of Olmsted's wide-ranging work on one of his other great projects the design of the grounds of George W Vanderbilt's massive estate Biltmore near Asheville North Carolina In planning the estate's thousands of acres Olmsted outlined new approaches to landscape design promoted the creation of the first scientific forestry operation in the United States designed a model residential subdivision and proposed an arboretum that would have been the most ambitious in the nation The Last Great Projects 1890-1895 chronicles the history of one of the world's greatest landscape design firms while offering a fascinating retrospective on Frederick Law Olmsted's productive final years The volume also gathers together the important documents of this last triumphant era As Olmsted neared the end of his career he wrote some of his most reflective letters and reports summarizing the legacy of his involvement with the U.S. Sanitary Commission the quality of landscape design in England and France the biographical circumstances that proved most important to his development as an artist and his hopes and fears for the future of his profession **The Wiley-Blackwell Encyclopedia of Urban and Regional Studies** Anthony M. The Roots of Flower City Camden Burd,2024-10-15 In The Roots of Flower City Camden Burd explores the economic and ecological significance of Rochester plant nurserymen over the course of the nineteenth century As the first boomtown in the United States Rochester was an embodiment of nineteenth century market economies and social reform movements Connected to the eastern seaboard by the Erie Canal the city s unique economic cultural and environmental conditions fostered and sustained a vast and influential commercial plant nursery industry that attracted the nation s most prominent horticulturists and nurserymen Rochester area nurserymen built parks and rural cemeteries landscaped homes and schools and promoted horticultural pursuits regionally and nationally As their influence grew many of these horticultural entrepreneurs developed into the city s elite and played a leading role in shaping Rochester s economic social and physical landscape Most significantly nurserymen enthusiastically participated in the American imperial project selling and distributing fruit shade and ornamental trees shrubs and flowers across the continent transforming landscapes and ecologies far beyond New York The Roots of Flower City tells the remarkable history of Rochester s outsized influence on the homes estates towns and cities of nineteenth century America as it weathered economic downturns and competition from other regions One threat however proved to be too much to overcome As Burd details the spread of the destructive San Jose scale through the transcontinental plant trade prompted federal legislation that would lead to the decline of the Rochester plant nursery industry in the last decade of the nineteenth century ending a sustained era of success and ecological impact
