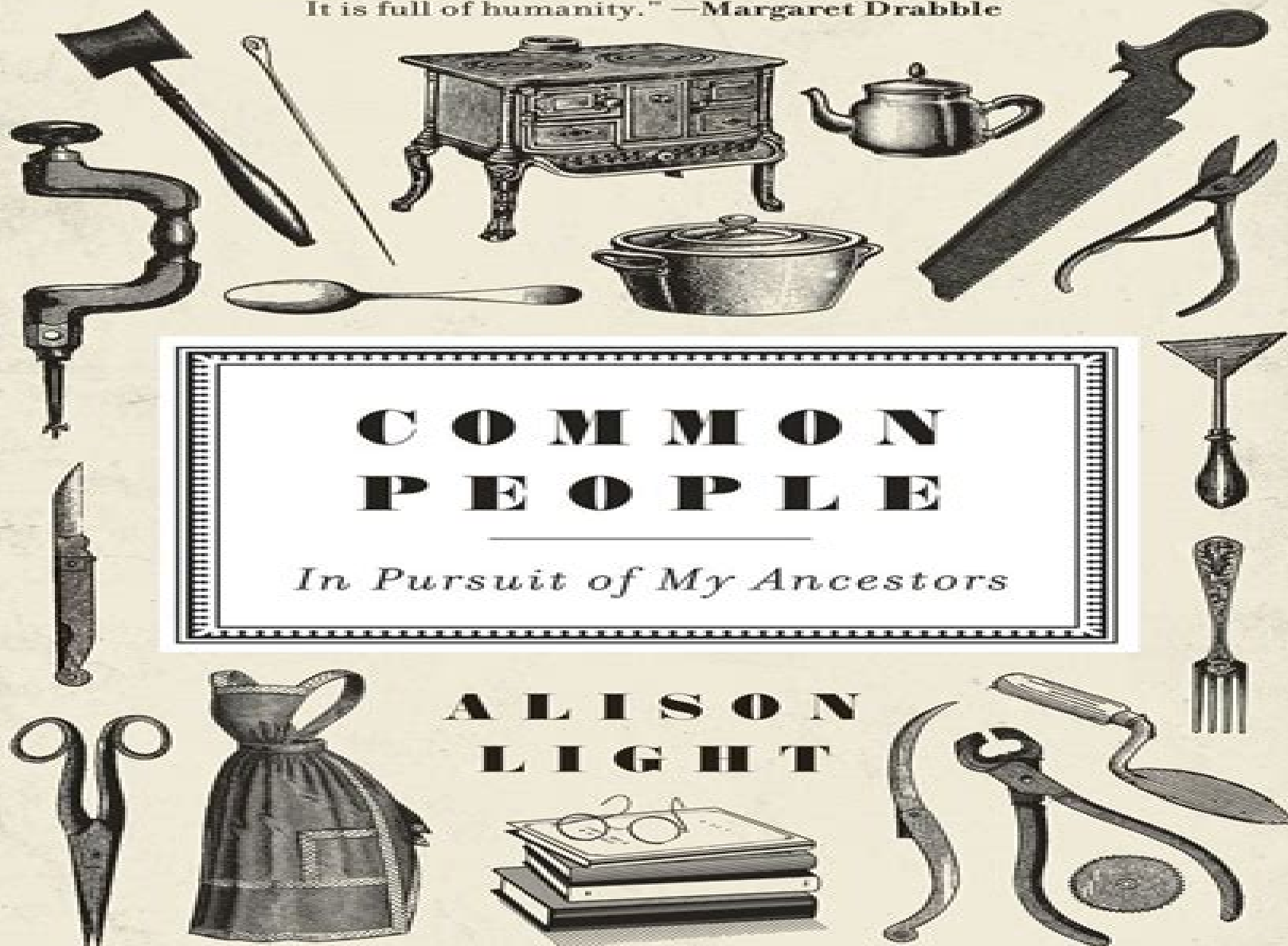

Common People Alison Light, 2015-09-17 Family history begins with missing persons Alison Light writes in *Common People* We wonder about those we've lost and those we never knew about the long skein that led to us and to here and to now So we start exploring Most of us however give up a few generations back We run into a gap get embarrassed by a neighbor do well or simply find our ancestors are less glamorous than we'd hoped That didn't stop Alison Light in the last weeks of her father's life she embarked on an attempt to trace the history of her family as far back as she could reasonably go The result is a clear-eyed fascinating frequently moving account of the lives of everyday people of the tough decisions and hard work the good luck and bad breaks that chart the course of a life Light's forebears servants sailors farm workers were among the poorest traveling the country looking for work they left few lasting marks on the world But through her painstaking work in archives and her ability to make the people and struggles of the past come alive Light reminds us that every life even glimpsed through the chinks of the census has its surprises and secrets What she did for the servants of Bloomsbury in her celebrated *Mrs Woolf and the Servants* Light does here for her own ancestors and by extension everyone's draws their experiences from the shadows of the past and helps us understand their lives estranged from us by time yet inextricably interwoven with our own Family history in her hands becomes a new kind of public history

Worldly Afterlives Julia Stephens, 2025-12-16 The hidden histories of empire told through the haunted afterlives of colonial migrations Indian migrants provided the labor that enabled the British Empire to gain control over a quarter of the world's population and territory In the mid 1800s the British government began building an elaborate bureaucracy to govern its mobile subjects issuing photo IDs lists of kin and wills It amassed records of workers belongings such as handwritten IOUs crumpled newspaper clippings and copper bangles *Worldly Afterlives* uses this trove of artifacts to recover the stories of the hidden subjects of empire Navigating the remains of imperial bureaucracy in archives scattered across Asia Africa the Middle East and the Americas Julia Stephens follows migrant families as they traverse the Indian Ocean and the British Empire She draws on in-depth interviews to show how the histories of empire reverberate in the present through the memories and experiences of their descendants who collected their own remnants of empire in albums and curio cabinets We encounter women subaltern migrants and people of mixed heritage whose family stories upend ethnonationalist and patriarchal approaches to studying Asian diasporas What emerges is a social history of Indian migration and a political history of British imperial governance one that offers a new methodological approach to the historian's craft Spanning archives family collections cemeteries online ancestry records and social media *Worldly Afterlives* breaks down boundaries that separate academic amateur and public history to open new conversations about the ongoing legacies of empire

An American Teacher in Argentina Julyan G. Peard, 2016-07-27 *An American Teacher in Argentina* tells the story of Mary E Gorman who in 1869 was the first North American woman to accept President Domingo F Sarmiento's invitation to set up normal schools in Argentina

where she eventually settled An ordinary historical actor whose life only sometimes enters the historical record she moved along the fault lines of some of the greatest historical dramas and changes in nineteenth century US and Argentine history she was a pioneering child on the US Indian frontier she participated in the push for US women s education she was a single woman traveler at a time when few women traveled alone she was a player in an Argentine attempt to expand common school education and a beneficiary of the great primary products export boom in the second half of nineteenth century Argentina and thus well positioned to enjoy the country s Belle poque The book is not a straightforward biographical narrative of a woman s life It charts a life but more important it charts the evolving ideas in a life lived mostly among people pushing boundaries in pursuit of what they considered progress What emerges is a quintessentially transnational life story that engages with themes of gender education religion contact with indigenous peoples in both the US and Argentina natural history and economic and political change in Argentina in the second half of the nineteenth century Because the book tells a good story about one woman s rich and eventful life it will also appeal to an audience beyond academe **A Nation of**
