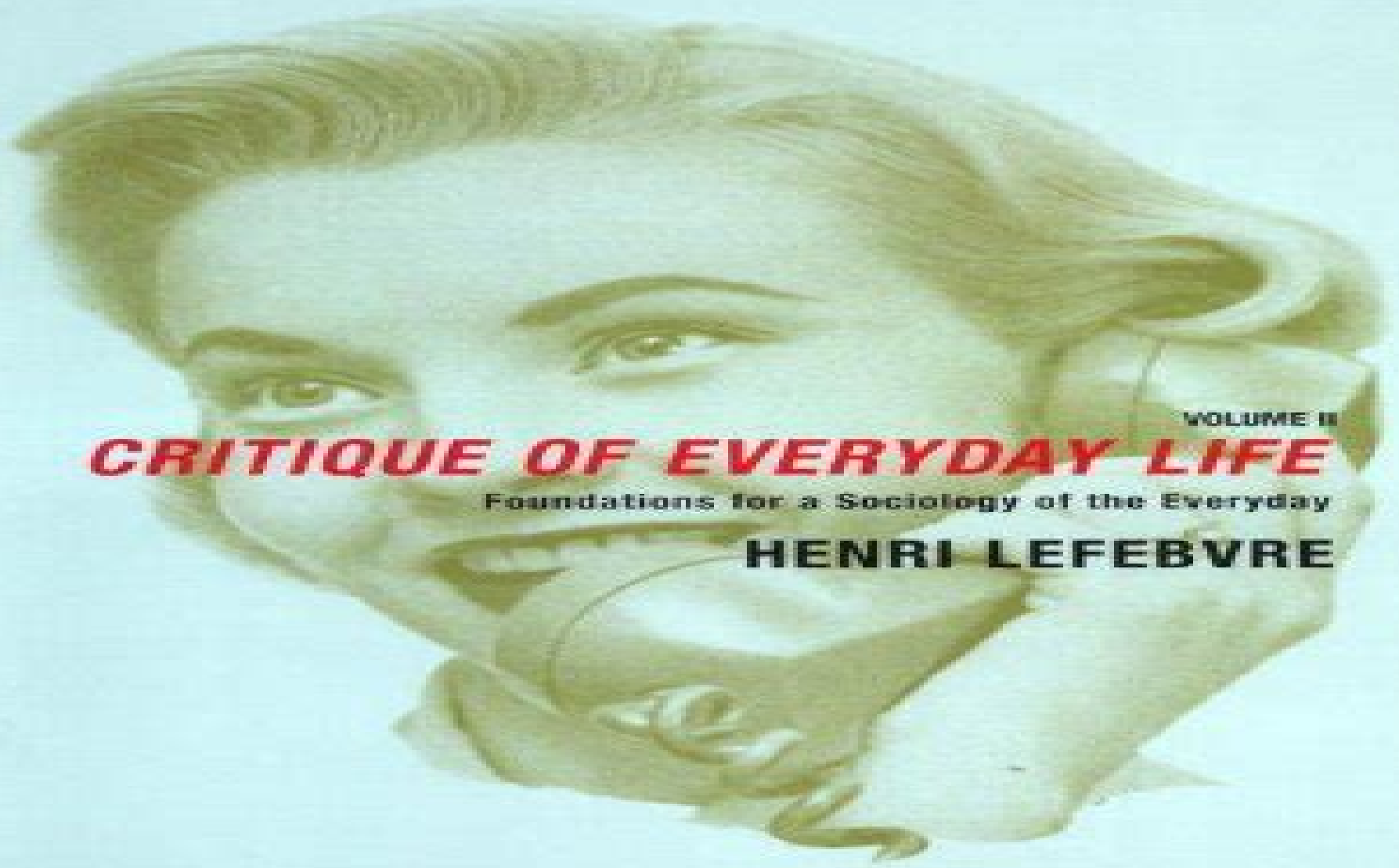

Critique of Everyday Life: Foundations for a sociology of the everyday Henri Lefebvre, 1991 Henri Lefebvre's three volume *Critique of Everyday Life* is perhaps the richest most prescient work by one of the twentieth century's greatest philosophers. The first volume presented an introduction to the concept of everyday life. Written twenty years later this second volume attempts to establish the necessary formal instruments for analysis and outlines a series of theoretical categories within everyday life such as the theory of the semantic field and the theory of moments. The moment at which the book appeared 1961 was significant both for France and for Lefebvre himself he was just beginning his career as a lecturer in sociology at Strasbourg and then at Nanterre and many of the ideas which were influential in the events leading up to 1968 are to be found in this critique. This is an enduringly radical text untimely today only in its intransigence and optimism. **Henry Green** Nick Shepley, 2016-07-29 Henry Green *Class Style and the Everyday* offers a critical prism through which Green's fiction from his earliest published short stories as an Eton schoolboy through to his last dialogic novels of the 1950s can be seen as a coherent subtle and humorous critique of the tension between class style and realism in the first half of the twentieth century. The study extends on going critical recognition that Green's work is central to the development of the novel from the twenties to the fifties acting as a vital bridge between late modernist inter war post war and postmodernist fiction. The overarching contention is that the shifting and destabilizing nature of Green's oeuvre sets up a predicament similar to that confronted by theorists of the everyday. Consequently each chapter acknowledges the indeterminacy of the writing whether it be the non singular functioning or malfunctioning of the name the open ended purposefully ambiguous nature of its symbols the shifting cinematic nature of

Green's prose style the sensitive but resolutely unsentimental depictions of the working classes and the aristocracy in the inter war period the impact of war and its inconsistent irruptions into daily life or the ways in which moments or events are rapidly subsumed back into the flux of the everyday their impact left uncertain Critics have historically offered up singular readings of Green's work or focused on the poetic or recreative qualities of certain works particularly those of the 1940s Green's writing is undoubtedly poetic and extraordinary but this book also pays attention to the clichéd meta-textual and uneventful aspects of his fiction Henri Lefebvre, Metaphilosophy, and Modernity Patrick Gamsby, 2025-08-22 Henri Lefebvre *Metaphilosophy and Modernity* provides a new interpretation of the work of Henri Lefebvre 1901-1991 reframing it as being above all a metaphilosophy of modernity Henri Lefebvre is increasingly being recognized as one of the great twentieth century thinkers Nevertheless the majority of scholarship on Lefebvre predominantly focuses on his theorizing of space often taking Lefebvre's *The Production of Space* as the point of departure and or on his theorizing of everyday life with his multi-volume *Critique of Everyday Life* as the focal point This book argues that it is Lefebvre's concept of metaphilosophy that provides the connective tissues for these works one that is chiefly concerned with deciphering the enigma of modernity The book will appeal to a wide interdisciplinary and international audience from the fields of sociology philosophy cultural studies geography the history of ideas and literary studies This includes scholars and students interested in Henri Lefebvre's writings everyday life modernity space time leisure work continental thought critical theory Marxism and technology
