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The Ambivalence of Good Jan Eckel, 2019-04-11 The Ambivalence of Good examines the genesis and evolution of international human rights politics since the 1940s Focusing on key developments such as the shaping of the UN human rights system decolonization the rise of Amnesty International the campaigns against the Pinochet dictatorship the moral politics of Western governments or dissidence in Eastern Europe the book traces how human rights profoundly if subtly transformed global affairs Moving beyond monocausal explanations and narratives prioritizing one particular decade such as the 1940s or the 1970s The Ambivalence of Good argues that we need a complex and nuanced interpretation if we want to understand the truly global reach of human rights and account for the hopes conflicts and interventions to which this idea gave rise Thus it portrays the story of human rights as polycentric demonstrating how actors in various locales imbued them with widely different meanings arguing that the political field evolved in a fitful and discontinuous process This process was shaped by consequential shifts that emerged from the search for a new world order during the Second World War decolonization the desire to introduce a new political morality into world affairs during the 1970s and the visions of a peaceful international order after the end of the Cold War Finally the book stresses that the projects pursued in the name of human rights nonetheless proved highly ambivalent Self interest was as strong a driving force as was the desire to help people in need and while international campaigns often improved the fate of the persecuted they were equally likely to have counterproductive effects The Ambivalence of Good provides the first research based synopsis of the topic and one of the first synthetic studies of a transnational political field such as population health or the environment during the twentieth century Based on archival research in six countries it breaks new empirical ground concerning the history of human rights in the United Nations of human rights NGOs of far flung mobilizations and of the uses of human rights in state foreign policy

Up from Conservatism Michael Lind, 2013-08-06 For nearly a decade Michael Lind worked closely as a writer and editor with the intellectual leaders of American conservatism Slowly he came to believe that the many prominent intellectuals he worked with were not the leaders of the conservative movement but the followers and apologists for an increasingly divisive and reactionary political strategy orchestrated by the Republican party Lind's disillusionment led to a very public break with his former colleagues on the right as he attacked the Reverend Pat Robertson for using anti-Semitic sources in his writings In *Up From Conservatism* this former rising star of the right reveals what he believes to be the disturbing truth about the hidden economic agenda of the conservative elite The Republican capture of the U S Congress in 1994 did not represent the conversion of the American public to conservative ideology Rather it marked the success of the thirty year old southern strategy begun by Barry Goldwater and Richard Nixon From the Civil War to the civil rights revolution the southern elite combined a low wage low tax strategy for economic development with a politics of demagoguery based on race baiting and Bible thumping Now Lind maintains the economic elite that controls the Republican party is following a similar strategy on a national scale using their power to shift the tax burden from the rich to the middle class while redistributing wealth upward To divert attention from their favoritism toward the rich conservatives play up the culture war channeling popular anger about falling real wages and living standards away from Wall Street and focusing it instead on the black poor and nonwhite immigrants The United States Lind concludes could use a genuine one nation conservatism that seeks to promote the interests of the middle class and the poor as well as the rich But today's elitist conservatism poses a clear and present danger to the American middle class and the American republic

Dangerous Doctrine Robert G. Kaufman, 2016-05-13 Much like Margaret Thatcher and Ronald Reagan President Barack Obama came to office as a politician who emphasized conviction rather than consensus During his 2008 presidential campaign he pledged to transform the role of the United States abroad

His ambitious foreign policy goals included a global climate treaty the peaceful withdrawal of American military forces from Iraq and Afghanistan and a new relationship with Iran Throughout Obama s tenure pundits and scholars have offered competing interpretations of his grand strategy while others have maintained that his policies were incoherent or at best ad hoc In *Dangerous Doctrine* political scientist Robert G Kaufman argues that the forty fourth president has indeed articulated a clear consistent national security policy and has pursued it with remarkable fidelity Yet Kaufman contends that President Obama has imprudently abandoned the muscular internationalism that has marked US foreign policy since the end of World War II Drawing on international relations theory and American diplomatic history Kaufman presents a robust critique of the Obama doctrine as he situates the president s use of power within the traditions of American strategic practice Focusing on the pivotal regions of Europe the Middle East and Asia this provocative study demonstrates how current executive branch leadership threatens America s role as a superpower weakening its ability to spread democracy and counter threats to geopolitical order in increasingly unstable times Kaufman proposes a return to the grand strategy of moral democratic realism as practiced by presidents such as Harry S Truman Ronald Reagan and George W Bush with the hope of reestablishing the United States as the world s dominant power
