

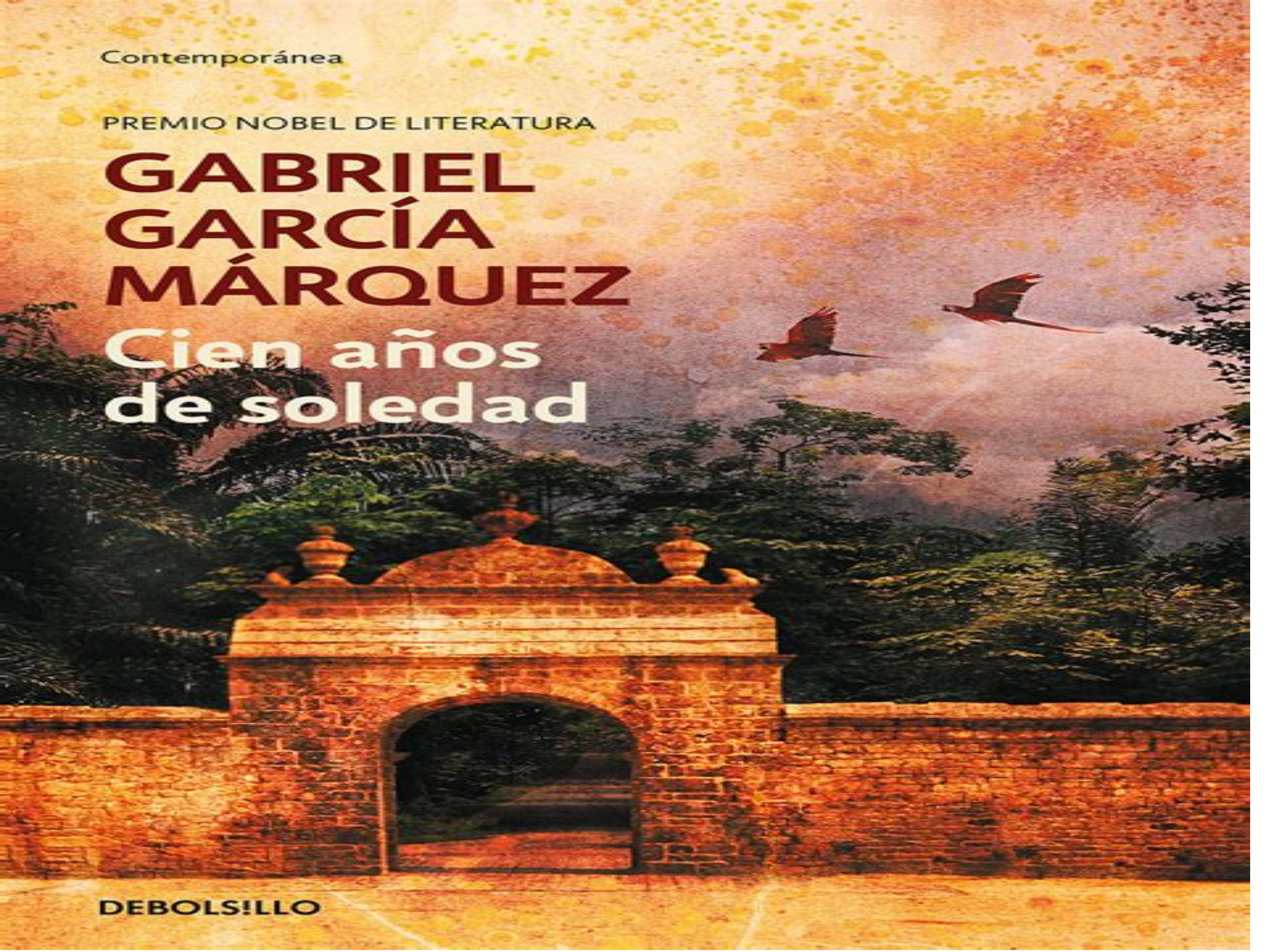

Hoy en día los latinos representan el veinte por ciento de la población de Estados Unidos cifra que sigue en aumento. Para 2050 los informes del censo prevén que uno de cada tres estadounidenses ser de ascendencia latina. Pero los latinos no son un monolito. No representan a un único grupo. Los más numerosos son los mexicanos puertorriqueños dominicanos salvadoreños y cubanos. Cada uno tiene un trasfondo cultural y político diferente. Los puertorriqueños por ejemplo son ciudadanos estadounidenses mientras que algunos mexicanos estadounidenses nunca emigraron debido a que la frontera entre Estados Unidos y México se desplazó tras la invasión estadounidense de 1848 incorporando lo que hoy es todo el suroeste de Estados Unidos. Los cubanos llegaron en dos grandes oleadas la de quienes escaparon del comunismo en los primeros años de Castro muchos de los cuales eran profesionales y ricos y la de los salieron con permiso en el exodo del Mariel veinte años después que representaban a algunos de los cubanos más pobres incluso los presos. Como lo muestra LatinoLand los latinos fueron de los primeros inmigrantes que llegaron a lo que hoy es Estados Unidos algunos en el siglo XVI. Racialmente son diversos una mezcla aleatoria de blancos negros indígenas y asiáticos. Alguna vez abrumadoramente católicos entre ellos hay cada vez más protestantes y evangélicos. Abarcan desde empleadas domésticas y jornaleros hasta artistas de éxito directivos de empresas y senadores estadounidenses. Herrero-Olaizola, 2012-02-01 Drawing on extensive research in the Spanish National Archive Alejandro Herrero Olaizola examines the role played by the censorship apparatus of Franco's Spain in bringing about the Latin American literary Boom of the 1960s and 1970s. He reveals the negotiations and behind the scenes maneuvering among those involved in the Spanish publishing industry. Converging interests made strange bedfellows of the often left wing authors and the staid officials appointed to stand guard over Francoist morality and to defend the supposed purity of Castilian Spanish. Between these two uneasily allied groups circulated larger than life real world characters like the Barcelona publisher Carlos Barral and the all powerful literary agent Carmen Balcells. The author details the fascinating story of how novels by Mario Vargas Llosa Guillermo Cabrera Infante Gabriel García Márquez and Manuel Puig achieved publication in Spain and in doing so reached a worldwide market. This colorful account underpins a compelling claim that even the most innovative and aesthetically challenging literature has its roots in the economics of the book trade as well as the institutions of government and the

exigencies of everyday politics and ideology The Spanish American Novel John S. Brushwood, 2014-07-03 In *The Spanish American Novel* John S. Brushwood analyzes the twentieth century Spanish American novel as an artistic expression of social reality. In relating the generic history of the novel to extraliterary events in Spanish America he shows how twentieth century fiction sets forth the essence of such phenomena as the first Perón regime, the Mexican Revolution, the Che Guevara legend, indigenismo and the strongman political type. In essence he views the novel as art rather than as document but not as art alienated from society. The discussion is organized chronologically, opening with the turn of the century and focusing on novels from 1900 to 1915 that exemplify various aspects of the nineteenth century literary inheritance. Brushwood then highlights the avant garde fiction influenced by Proust and Joyce of the 1920s as a precursory movement to the new Latin American novel, a phenomenon that came into its own during the 1940s. He then examines the boom in Spanish American fiction, the period of extensive international recognition of certain works which he dates from 1962 or 1963. In each era considered the development of the novel is placed in dual perspective. One view, that of particularly significant novels in light of others published during the same year, is a cross section of the genre at one particular moment. The second view, that of a panorama of novels published in intervals between significant moments in the history of the novel, is more general and selective in the number of books discussed. Combining the historical with the analytical approach, the author proposes that the experience of a novel in which reality has been transformed into art is essential to our understanding of that reality.

Ambiguity and Gender in the New Novel of Brazil and Spanish America Judith A. Payne, Earl E. Fitz, 1993-05 In this first book length study to compare the new novels of both Spanish America and Brazil, the authors deftly examine the differing perceptions of ambiguity as they apply to questions of gender and the participation of females and males in the establishment of Latin American narrative models. Their daring thesis: the Brazilian new novel developed a more radical form than its better known Spanish speaking cousin because it had a significantly different approach to the crucial issues of ambiguity and gender and because so many of its major practitioners were women. As a wise strategy for assessing the canonical new novels from Latin America, the coupling of ambiguity and gender enables Payne and Fitz to discuss how borders literary, generic and cultural are maintained, challenged or crossed. Their conclusions illuminate the contributions of the new novel in terms of experimental structures and narrative techniques as well as the significant roles of voice, theme and language. Using Jungian theory and a poststructural optic, the authors also demonstrate how the Latin American new novel faces such universal subjects as myth, time, truth and reality. Perhaps the most original aspect of their study lies in its analysis of Brazil's strong female tradition. Here issues such as alternative

visions contrasexuality self consciousness and ontological speculation gain new meaning for the future of the novel in Latin America With its comparative approach and its many bilingual quotations *Ambiguity and Gender in the New Novel of Brazil and Spanish America* offers an engaging picture of the marked differences between the literary traditions of Portuguese speaking and Spanish speaking America and thus new insights into the distinctive mindsets of these linguistic cultures

From the Edge Allison E.
