2.1 The Functions of an Information System

The concept information system began to emerge around 1960. Even though it may be considered an old concept, it is still difficult to define what an IS is. Part of that difficulty is because ISs can be analyzed in at least three distinct and complementary perspectives [1]:

- The contribution they provide;
- Their structure and behavior;
- · The functions they perform.

From the first perspective, ISs are defined as means for wider systems to achieve their objectives. That kind of definition emphasizes that ISs are subsystems of wider systems, to which they contribute. An IS does not exist for itself. Examples of that kind of definition would be: "An IS is a system designed to support operations, management, and decision-making in an organization" or "An IS is a system that facilitates communication among its users."
