Verhoeven, 1998-01-01 Kugeltopf **A History of Brewing in Holland, 900-1900** Richard Unger, 2001-07-26 This book offers a comprehensive history of brewing in Holland from the beginnings of large scale production at the end of the first millennium through medieval expansion the boom of the Renaissance and the disastrous decline of the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries It closes with the revival of the industry in the era of industrialization Major technical innovations from Germany in the fourteenth and again in the nineteenth century made it possible for brewing to take a leading role in the Dutch economy The adaptation of those improvements went on always under the careful supervision of the state Relying on the extensive records of urban and provincial governments the author traces the cooperation as well as tension between brewers and public authorities spanning one thousand years *The Rise of the Amsterdam Market and Information Exchange* Clé Lesger, 2016-12-05 Most scholars agree that during the sixteenth century the centre of European international trade shifted from Antwerp to Amsterdam presaging the economic rise of the Dutch Republic in the following century Traditionally this shift has been accepted as the natural consequence of a dynamic and progressive city such as Amsterdam taking advantage of expanding commercial opportunities at the expense of a more conservative rival hampered by outmoded medieval practices Yet whilst this theory is widely accepted is it accurate In this groundbreaking study Cl Lesger argues that the shift of commercial power from Antwerp to Amsterdam was by no means inevitable and that the highly specialized economy of the Low Countries was more than capable of adapting to the changing needs of international trade It was only when the Dutch Revolt and military campaigns literally divided the Low Countries into separate states that the existing stable spatial economy and port system fell apart and a restructuring was needed Within this process of restructuring the port of Amsterdam acquired a function radically different to the one it had prior to the division of the Netherlands Before the Revolt it had served as the northern outpost in a gateway system centred on Antwerp but with access of that port now denied to the new republic Amsterdam developed as the main centre for Dutch shipping trade and crucially the exchange of information Drawing on a wide variety of neglected archival collections including those of the Bank of Amsterdam this study not only addresses specific historical questions concerning the commercial life of the Low Countries but through the case study of Amsterdam also explores wider issues of early modern European commercial trade and economic development **History of the Low Countries** J. For historical reasons parts of northern France and western Germany also have to be included in the Low Countries a term that must remain both broad and fluid a convenient label for a region which has seldom if ever composed a unified whole In earlier ages it as even more difficult to the region set parameters again reflecting Europe as a whole when tribes and kingdoms stretched across expanses not limited to the present states of Belgium Luxembourg and the Netherlands Nevertheless its parts did demonstrate many common traits and similar developments that differentiated them from surrounding countries and lent them a distinct character Internationally the region often served both as a mediator for and a buffer to the surrounding great powers France Britain and Germany an important role still played today as Belgium and the Netherlands have increasingly become involved in the broader process of European integration in which they often share the same interest and follow parallel policies This highly illustrated volume serves as an ideal introduction to the rich history of the Low Countries for students and the generally interested reader alike

Calvinists and Catholics during Holland's Golden Age Christine Kooi, 2012-04-30 This book examines the social political and religious relationships between Calvinists and Catholics during Holland s Golden Age Although Holland the largest province of the Dutch Republic was officially Calvinist its population was one of the most religiously heterogeneous in early modern Europe The Catholic Church was officially disestablished in the 1570s yet by the 1620s Catholicism underwent a revival flourishing in a semi clandestine private sphere The book focuses on how Reformed Protestants dealt with this revived Catholicism arguing that confessional coexistence between Calvinists and Catholics operated within a number of contiguous and overlapping social political and cultural spaces The result was a paradox a society that was at once Calvinist and pluralist Christine Kooi maps the daily interactions between people of different faiths and examines how religious boundaries were negotiated during an era of tumultuous religious change

Power and Urban Space in Pre-Modern Holland Clé Lesger, 2024-02-22 Cities and urban societies have many faces In this study the pre modern cities of Holland are presented as arenas where power relations between social classes are expressed in a more or less permanent appropriation of physical space and through discursive strategies The continuity of the power relations in the cities of Holland spanning centuries makes it urgent to look not only at the assumption of urban space as an expression of power relations within society but also at the contribution of this appropriation to the acceptance and continuity of the existing power relations in pre modern Holland Within this broad area extensive attention is paid to the very prominent and enduring appropriation of urban space in the field of housing the less permanent but violent appropriation of urban space during the public execution of scaffold punishments the maintenance of public order by civic militias and appropriation during riots and revolts In addition city descriptions maps and pictures of the pre modern cities of Holland are scrutinised for what they can reveal about the appropriation of urban spaces These themes each have an extensive historiography but they have never been brought together in an interpretative framework that fits in with Pierre Bourdieu s model of society and the work of especially John Allen on power until now

Origin of the Dutch coastal landscape Peter Vos, 2015-06-30 The topic of this book is the Origin of the Dutch coastal landscape during the Holocene. The landscape evolution is visualized in series of palaeogeographical maps and the driving mechanisms behind the environmental changes are discussed. The practice to make palaeogeographical map reconstructions in the Netherlands developed after the Second World War when a lot of regional geological and soil scientific mapping programs were carried out by government institutions and universities. These maps show when and how the surveyed sediments were formed. The palaeogeographical map reconstructions are subsequently used for the understanding and modeling of the long term coastal evolution, coastal management issues, landscape archaeological purposes and for education and public information reasons. Geoarchaeological investigations play an important role in this study. Geological and palaeo environmental data from archaeological excavations, key sites provided essential information for the palaeolandscapes reconstructions. In the presented regional and local case studies of this book, examples of these sites are shown.

War, State, and Society in England and the Netherlands 1477-1559 Steven Gunn, David Grummitt, Hans Cools, 2007-11-15 Exploring the effects of war on state power in early modern Europe, this book asks if military competition increased rulers' power over their subjects and forged more modern states or if the strains of war broke down political and administrative systems. Comparing England and the Netherlands in the age of warrior princes such as Henry VIII and Charles V, it examines the development of new military and fiscal institutions and asks how mobilization for war changed political relationships throughout society. Towns in England such as Norwich, York, Exeter and Rye are compared with towns in the Netherlands such as Antwerp, Leiden, s Hertogenbosch and Valenciennes to see how the magistrates' relations with central government and the urban populace were modified by war. Great noblemen from the Howard and Percy families are set alongside their equivalents from the houses of Cro and Egmond to examine the role of recruitment, army command and heroic reputation in maintaining noble power. The wider interactions of subjects and rulers in wartime are reviewed to measure how effectively war extended princes' claims on their subjects' loyalty and service, their ambitions to control news and opinion and to promote national identity, and their ability to manage the economy and harness religious change to dynastic purposes. The result is a compelling but nuanced picture of societies and polities tested and shaped by the pressures of ever more demanding warfare.

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
