W. Matthews, 2011 Dietrich Bonhoeffer's life spanned four decades of the early twentieth century and was shaped within the crucible of two European wars and an economic depression. Born in 1906 and raised in an upper middle class German family, he was educated to be a pastor, further trained as a theologian, involved in a plot to assassinate Adolf Hitler, and was finally hanged by the Nazis only days before the end of World War II. His life story is more than one more tragic episode in the history and horrors of the Holocaust. Bonhoeffer's life cannot be simply summarized as only one of trauma and tragedy. His was also a life filled with great blessing even when requiring great courage and incredible sacrifice. His relationships were life giving and his experiences were rich. The authenticity of Bonhoeffer's Christian faith and the integrity of his theology continues to inspire people. During that time when most people understandably struggled to protect their own lives as well as the lives of those they loved, he often ventured by faith into uncertain territory, risking his reputation and life to advocate for others. Dietrich Michael Pasquarello, 2025-03-26 Dietrich Bonhoeffer 1906-1945 remains one of the most enigmatic figures of the twentieth century. His life evokes fascination, eliciting attention from a wide and diverse audience. Bonhoeffer is rightly remembered as theologian and philosopher, ethicist and political thinker, wartime activist and resister, church leader and pastor, martyr and saint. These many sides to Bonhoeffer do not give due prominence to the aspect of his life that wove all the disparate parts into a coherent whole: Bonhoeffer as preacher. In *Dietrich Bonhoeffer and the Theology of a Preaching Life*, Michael Pasquarello traces the arc of Bonhoeffer's public career, demonstrating how at every stage Bonhoeffer focused upon preaching, both in terms of its ecclesial practice and the theology that gave it life. Pasquarello chronicles a period of preparation: Bonhoeffer's study of Luther and Barth, his struggle to reconcile practical ministry with preaching, and his discovery of preaching's ethic of resistance. Next, Pasquarello describes Bonhoeffer's maturation as a preacher, his crafting of a homiletic theology, as well as preaching's relationship to politics and public confession. Pasquarello follows Bonhoeffer's forced itinerancy until he became ultimately a preacher without any congregation at all. In the end, Bonhoeffer's life was his best sermon. Dietrich presents Bonhoeffer as an exemplar in the preaching tradition of the church. His exercise of theological and homiletical wisdom in particular times, places, and circumstances—Berlin, Barcelona, Harlem, London, Finkenwalde—reveals the particular kind of intellectual, spiritual, and moral formation required for faithful, concrete witness to the gospel in the practice of proclamation, both then and now. Bonhoeffer's

story as a pastor and teacher of preachers provides a historical example of how the integration of theology and ministry is the fruit of wisdom cultivated through a life of discipleship with others in prayer study scriptural meditation and mutual service

Strange Glory Charles Marsh, 2014-04-29 In the decades since his execution by the Nazis in 1945 Dietrich Bonhoeffer the German pastor theologian and anti Hitler conspirator has become one of the most widely read and inspiring Christian thinkers of our time Now drawing on extensive new research Strange Glory offers a definitive account by turns majestic and intimate of this modern icon The scion of a grand family that rarely went to church Dietrich decided as a thirteen year old to become a theologian By twenty one the rather snobbish and awkward young man had already written a dissertation hailed by Karl Barth as a theological miracle But it was only the first step in a lifelong effort to recover an authentic and orthodox Christianity from the dilutions of liberal Protestantism and the modern idolatries of blood and nation which forces had left the German church completely helpless against the onslaught of Nazism From the start Bonhoeffer insisted that the essence of Christianity was not its abstract precepts but the concrete reality of the shared life in Christ In 1930 his search for that true fellowship led Bonhoeffer to America for ten fateful months in the company of social reformers Harlem churchmen and public intellectuals Energized by the lived faith he had seen he would now begin to make what he later saw as his definitive turn from the phraseological to the real He went home with renewed vocation and took up ministry among Berlin s downtrodden while trying to find his place in the hoary academic establishment increasingly captive to nationalist fervor With the rise of Hitler however Bonhoeffer s journey took yet another turn The German church was Nazified along with every other state sponsored institution But it was the Nuremberg laws that set Bonhoeffer s earthly life on an ineluctable path toward destruction His denunciation of the race statutes as heresy and his insistence on the church s moral obligation to defend all victims of state violence regardless of race or religion alienated him from what would become the Reich church and even some fellow resisters Soon the twenty seven year old pastor was one of the most conspicuous dissidents in Germany He would carry on subverting the regime and bearing Christian witness whether in the pastorate he assumed in London the Pomeranian monastery he established to train dissenting ministers or in the worldwide ecumenical movement Increasingly though Bonhoeffer would find himself a voice crying in the wilderness until finally he understood that true moral responsibility obliged him to commit treason for which he would pay with his life Charles Marsh brings Bonhoeffer to life in his full complexity for the first time With a keen understanding of the multifaceted writings often misunderstood as well as the imperfect man behind the saintly image here is a nuanced exhilarating and often heartrending portrait that lays bare Bonhoeffer s flaws and inner torment as well as the friendships and the faith that sustained and finally redeemed him Strange Glory is a momentous achievement Ecumenical, Academic, and Pastoral Work, 1931-1932 Dietrich Bonhoeffer, 2012 Volume 11 in the sixteen volume Dietrich Bonhoeffer Works English Edition Ecumenical Academic and Pastoral Work 1931 1932 provides a comprehensive translation of Bonhoeffer s important writings from 1931 to 1932 with
