rom schools to parking lots to basements, adolescents are using illicit substances. Drug and alcohol use is common in healthy youth and is even more prevalent in those youth who are psychiatrically ill. The morbidity associated with substance use makes it a public health concern. For these reasons, screening for substance use and intervention and treatment when this behavior grows problematic are important clinical practice issues for mental health clinicians working with youth.

The management of problems associated with substance use in youth has been viewed as a special challenge owing to a unique confluence of culture, behavior, confidentiality, comorbidity, and severity of psychopathology. In fact, child and adolescent psychiatrists often feel neither comfortable with nor capable of managing addiction in adolescents. At the same time, addiction psychiatrists, who do not have expertise in adolescent mental health and development, school systems, and parent management often see adolescents as outside their province. Because adolescents with substance use problems are "too young" for addiction psychiatrists and "too addicted" for child and adolescent psychiatrists, they are effectively a large but underserved population of patients.

Thus, the field of adolescent addiction exists in an interdisciplinary gap with an inadequate but thankfully growing body of literature for clinicians. Pagliaro and Pagliaro's 2011 Handbook of Child and Adolescent Drug and Substance Abuse: Pharmacological, Developmental, and Clinical Considerations is a useful resource for understanding the psychological aspects of substance abuse, whereas Kaminer and Winter's 2010 Clinical Manual of Adolescent Substance Abuse Treatment is a solid, concise treatment guide. The Clinical Handbook of, Adolescent Addiction, edited by Richard Rosner, MD, is the newest addition to this library. It

effectively bridges the interdisciplinary gap with its comprehensive coverage of the field from pathophysiology to treatment to emerging addictions (Internet, gaming, and even sexting) to the impact of the DSM-5 on the field.

Although dozens of writers contributed to the 7 sections of the Clinical Handbook of Adolescent Addiction, this volume maintains a consistent tone and structure throughout. It begins with upto-date epidemiologic accounts of the extent and nature of substance abuse by teens in the United States, United Kingdom, and, to a lesser degree, other European countries and Australia. The second section provides a comprehensive guide to all aspects of assessment. It covers the setting of the clinical encounter, comorbidities, and sociocultural assessments and includes an excellent chapter on the technical details of drug-testing methods. This section also reviews developmental aspects of the neurobiology of addiction. In the third section, we learn about prevention and how to assess risk by stratifying by age, gender, genetics, environment, medical conditions, and comorbid psychiatric conditions.

Each of the major classes of substances abused (i.e., alcohol, stimulants, opioids, cannabis, hallucinogens, nicotine, and sedative-hypnotics) is discussed in detail in its own chapter in section 4. This section also contains important chapters about less familiar (but not uncommon) addictions such as gambling, pomography, the Internet, video games, and binge eating. Each chapter reviews all aspects of a disorder, from epidemiology to assessment to treatment.

Next, section 5 of this volume is devoted to treatment modalities (including psychopharmacology) and treatment settings. This section also contains useful chapters on effective implementation and outcomes of various treatments.

These first 5 sections of the handbook provide a solid foundation to derive maximal value from the final—and arguably most interesting sections, which delve into forensics and other special issues in the field of adolescent addiction. The forensic section is of particular practical utility for clinicians because it provides medicolegal guidelines for obtaining consent from adolescents and their parents and for handling delicate issues surrounding confidentiality. The "Special Issues" section covers a broad range of topics that are unique to young substance users. These include a discussion of substance abuse
